

WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

INTRODUCTION

A majority of North Rift Valley leaders have decried increased case of insecurity following the Government decision to conduct fresh recruitment for National Police Reservists. They have so far called a speedup in the process after more than 700 residents fled their homes and schools closed for fear of banditry attacks in the area.

Other than the above, there were notable concerns of murder and suicide cases reported in Nairobi and Rest of the Country. In Nairobi, two police officers were over the weekend found dead at their houses in two separate incidents.

Reports from Rest of the Counties show that two couples killed their spouses and later committed suicide in Vihiga and Kiambu Counties.




HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI


The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- DCI detectives rescued a 7-year-old boy from a rental house in Kawangware after he was on Tuesday kidnapped from his home in Loresho.
- Police in Kasarani are investigating the cause of a fire that on Thursday razed down Thome Police Post to ashes.
- A police officer attached to Parliament Police Station was on Saturday found murdered at her house in Umoja.
- Two robbers on Saturday night made away with valuables after they raided a home in Spring Valley.
- The body of an officer attached to Umoja II Administration Police Post was on Sunday found by his colleagues in his house in a suspected suicide case
- Customs official at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport on Sunday intercepted bhang that was destined for London.
- A couple walking on Warai South road in Karen was on Monday robbed at gunpoint by suspected bod boda thugs.

ANALYSIS OF CRIME INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI




A clean-up exercise on Nairobi River saw the total number of bodies retrieved from it stand at 14 by Friday last week.




There was a slight increase of incidents reported in Residential Areas as compared to a similar period last year.

ANALYSIS OF CRIME INCIDENTS IN KENYA




A total of 29 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country




AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- Two armed robbers on Tuesday night stormed an M-Pesa shop and stole Ksh 489,600 in Kambu market in Kibwezi, Makueni County.
- Police are investigating an incident in which a 50-yearold man on Tuesday killed his wife before taking his life in Kiamumbi estate off Kamiti Road, Kiambu County.
- A suspected highway robber was on Wednesday morning shot by police after he was caught blocking the Naivasha-Kirima road in Nakuru County.
- A police officer is accused to have on Wednesday assaulted a 19-year-old student in Mukhwayo, Busia County.
- Two people were on Thursday confirmed dead in Saba Hills village in Marsabit County in a suspected retaliatory attack.
- A businesswoman on Thursday morning stabbed to death a suspected robber who had broken into her kiosk at Ngangarithi estate in Nyeri County.

- A 30-year-old man is nursing serious injuries after his wife on Friday chopped off his private parts inside their house at Khalaba, Bungoma County.
- Four criminals were on Friday arrested following a police raid at Nyalenda estate in Kisumu County.
- A 40-year-old man is alleged to have on Friday killed his wife and later committed suicide at their home in Kegoye, Vihiga County.
- Property of unknown amount was on Saturday destroyed after a fire erupted at Mombasa Cage Inn Hotel in Changamwe.
- Police on Sunday morning recovered a body of a 30-yearold man in an unoccupied building in Vijiweni area of Likoni in Mombasa County.
- One person was on Sunday shot dead and another seriously injured by bandits in Cheputulel on the border of West Pokot and Elgeyo Marakwet Counties.

Police in Thika on Monday intercepted bhang worth Ksh 5 million stashed in ten sacks on transit to the populous Kiandutu slums, Kiambu County.
