The upsurge of criminal cases involving the procurement and sale of fake gold in the Country has seen the Directorate of Criminal Investigation issue stern warning to the notorious fake gold merchants.

This follows the numerous arrests made in Nairobi alone for the past two months. In this regard, the general public and foreign nationals are advised to conduct proper due diligence and reach out to the Departments of Mining and Geology before engaging in gold buying business



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- More than 300 structures were on Tuesday razed down by a fire in Kibera slums that started from a house in Laini Saba before spreading to others.
- Police arrested a man suspected to have on Wednesday seriously assaulted a woman in Kayole.
- An unknown number of armed men on Thursday evening raided a shop on Luthuli Avenue. They made away with cash and valuables.
- Police officers acting on a tip off on Friday intercepted a fuel tanker stashed with Sh8 million worth of Ethiopian bhang on the Thika Superhighway en route to Nairobi City Centre.
- A mentally handicapped man is nursing injuries after he was on Saturday attacked by irate residents who accused him of stealing clothes at Mukuru-Maasai in Starehe.
- Fifteen fake gold syndicate suspects were on Monday arrested at their posh Kileleshwa premise with bags of cement and sledge hammers stuffed into metal boxes and passed off as gold heroin following a crackdown of drug traffickers at Kampala Ndogo in Mathare, Nairobi.

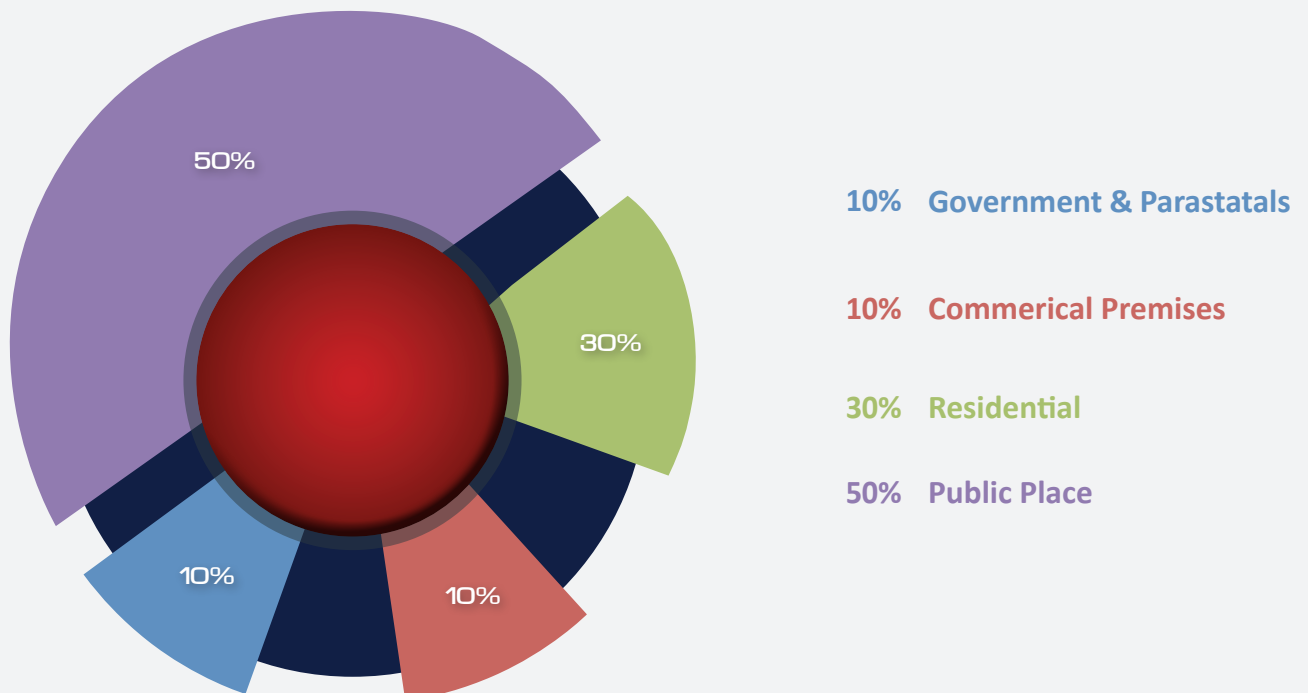

The Kenya Revenue Authority Department came into limelight this week following the DCI crackdown

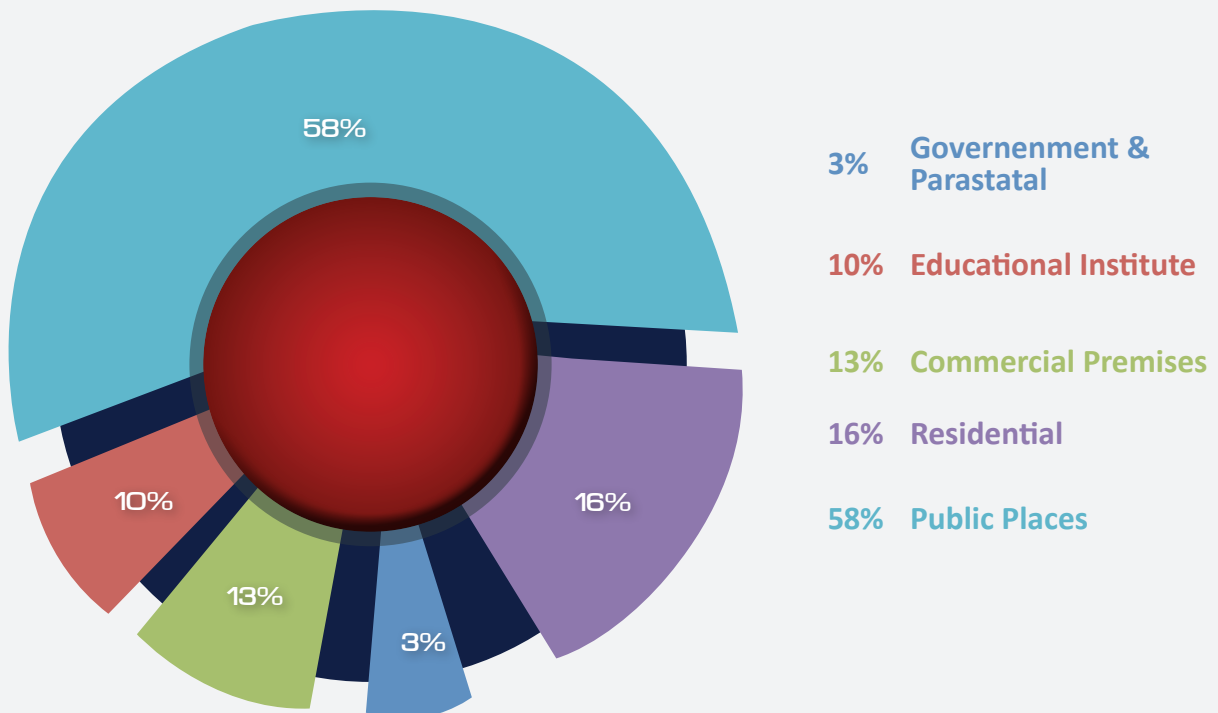

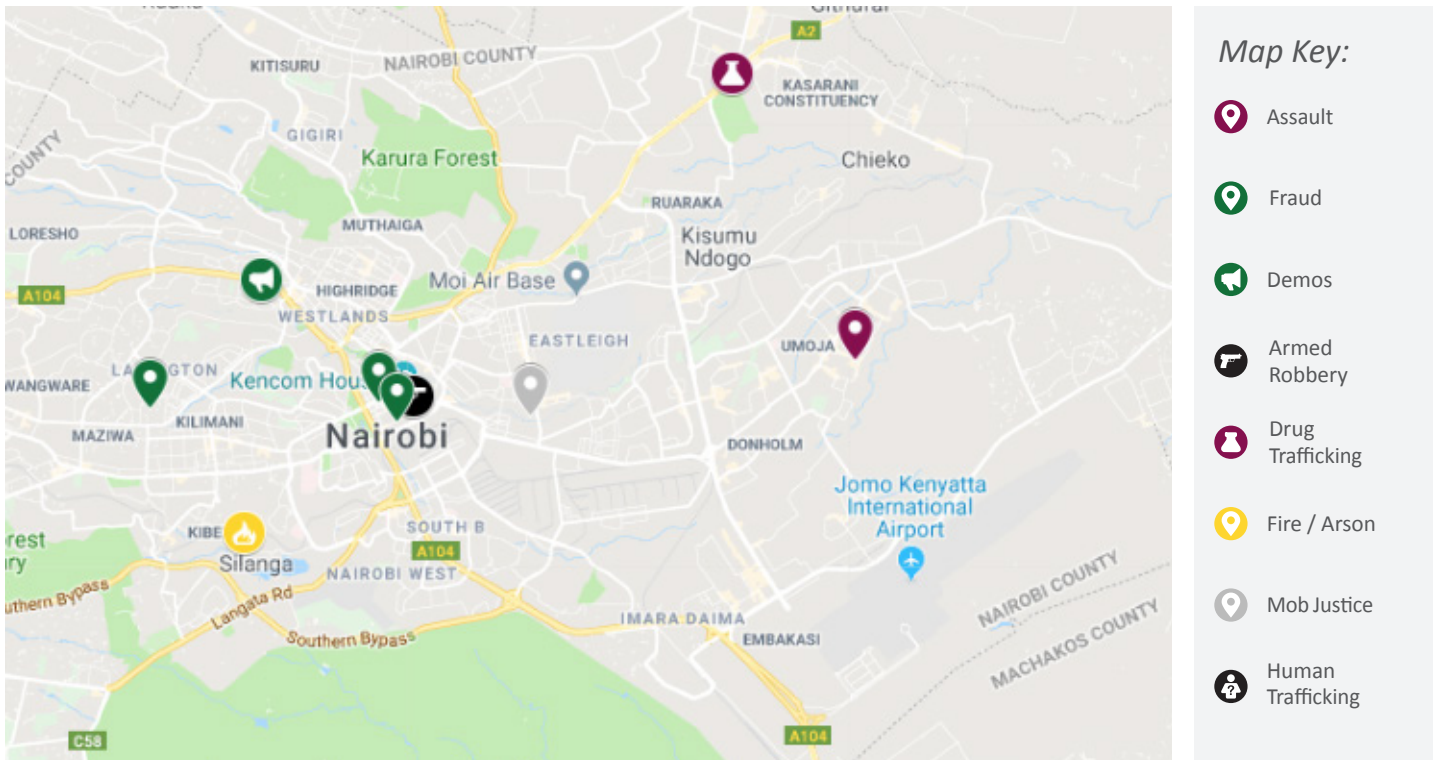
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



There was a slight increase of incidents reported in the commercial premises as compared to the two previous weeks

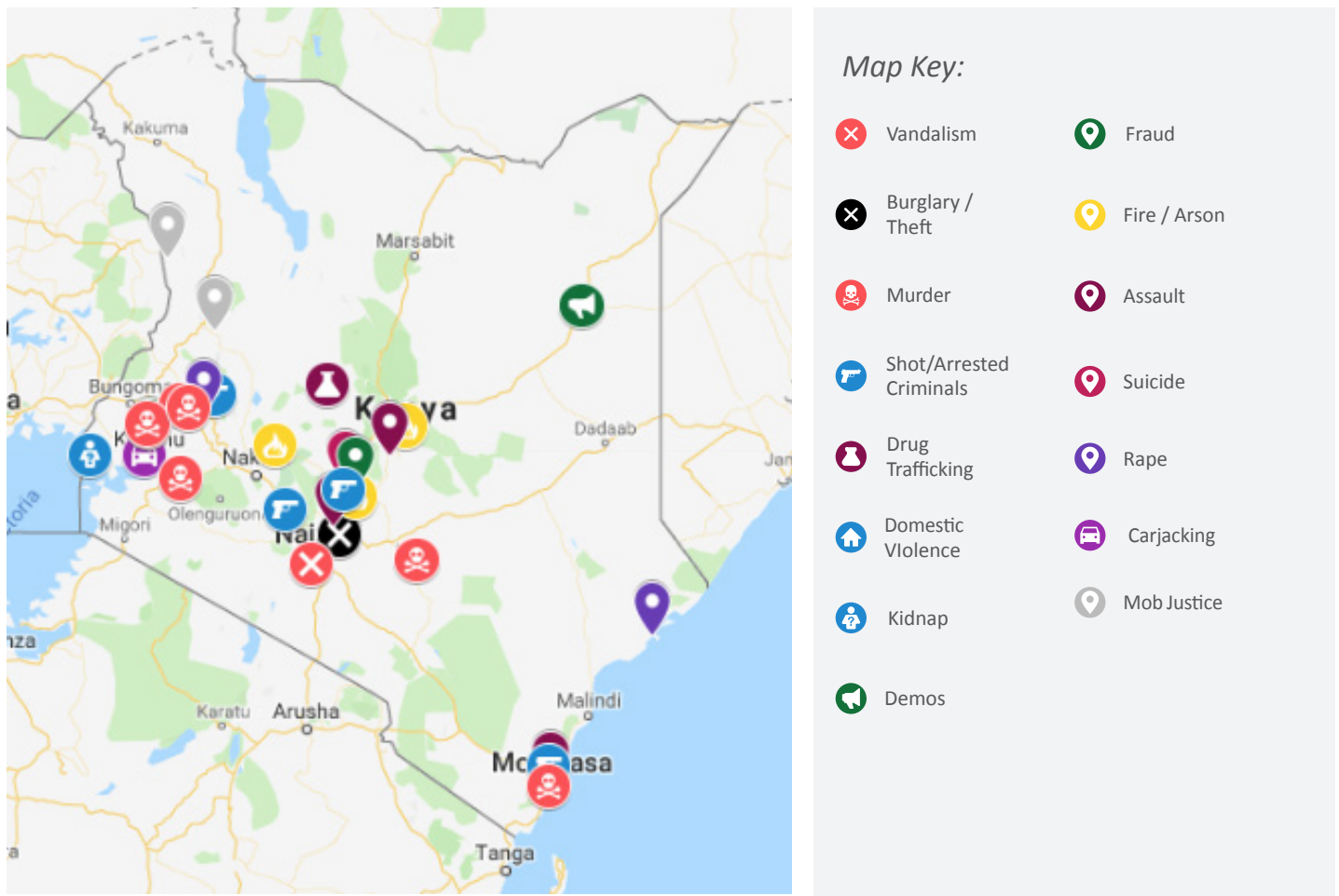
AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- A matatu tout was on Tuesday allegedly murdered by unknown assailants at Masingo slums in Kakamega County
- Police in Kitui County are holding a 19-year-old man who on Tuesday night allegedly slashed his newly married 18-year-old wife to death at Katithini village
- Property worth millions of shillings were on Wednesday destroyed when a fire broke out at Njega Boys Secondary School in Kirinyaga County
- A private security guard is reported to have on Wednesday beat and injured a police officer in Likoni, Mombasa County after a scuffle ensued between them
- Police in Kisumu County on Thursday night killed a suspected thug and recovered a lorry that had been stolen at Otongolo area
- A man from Mogotio in Baringo County is suspected to have on Thursday evening hacked his neighbour to death for allegedly having an affair with his wife
- Police are in pursuit of a suspected teacher who is accused to have on Friday kidnapped two children aged four years and five years from Ururi village in Bondo, Siaya County
- Detectives have launched investigations after a 45-year-old man on Friday hacked to death a 29-year-old woman in Kipkaren Center, Uasin Gishu County
- Police on Saturday arrested three suspects and seized 133 bundles of bhang worth Sh6 million at Kirimon-Lounoi village in Samburu County
- A suspected rustler who had intention of stealing livestock was on Saturday shot dead in Kerio Valley, Elgeyo Marakwet
- Police in Nyeri County on Sunday gunned down three armed robbers who had attempted to break into business premises at Karatina town
- The body of a middle-aged man was on Sunday found dangling from a tree by the roadside at Kiamwangi area of Mathira West, Nyeri County
- A middle-aged woman on Monday killed her three children and later committed suicide under unclear circumstances at Lami Juu area in Sosiot, Kericho County
- Police officers in Naivasha on Monday foiled an attempted robbery at Shell Petrol Station along Moi South Lake road
