INTRODUCTION

The Kenyan Government is set to spend heavily on security following the recently released budget for the financial year 2019-2020.

This will help enhance security both within the Country and along its borders as per the Sh325 billion proposed budget on the various security agencies.

For instance, part of the Sh140 billion allocated to the Interior Ministry will facilitate the installation of CCTV cameras in Nairobi, Mombasa, Kisumu, Nakuru and Eldoret.



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

There was a notable drop of crime-related activities in major parts of Nairobi County following the activation of the Nyumba Kumi program and recruitment of youths to various projects. Despite these initiatives, below were the highlights noted in the previous week:


- Police are investigating an incident where thugs on Tuesday night raided a city hotel and made away with property of unknown value.
- Three people were on Tuesday burnt to death after a fire broke out a lodging facility near Kenya Bus Station in Nairobi's CBD.
- Police and staff of a private security company are under investigation after Ksh. 2 million they were escorting went missing on Friday in Industrial Area, Nairobi.
- Three suspected thugs were over the weekend shot dead by police in a botched robbery in Buru-Buru, Nairobi.
- A guard was on Saturday evening shot and wounded during a robbery incident at a Clothes Shop located near Lonrho House in Nairobi's CBD.
- More than 300 families in Nairobi's Mukuru Kwa Njenga slum in Embakasi West spent the Sunday night in cold after a fire razed down their houses.
- A 26-year-old man was on Sunday drugged and accosted in Ngara by suspected thugs.
- Three traffic police officers were on Monday evening arrested for allegedly soliciting bribes from motorists along the Nyerere road in Nairobi.
- A man is on the run after he on Monday night attacked and seriously injured his wife at their home in Embakasi, Nairobi County.







BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS




- A five-year-old girl was on Tuesday found defiled and murdered in Oloombokishi area of Narok County
- Business was on Tuesday paralyzed in Marsabit town as rowdy boda-boda operators engaged police in running battles over alleged harassment
- Police in Kakamega are holding two men accused to have on Wednesday taken hostage and defiled a 14-year-old girl at Lurambi Estate
- Suspected cattle rustlers on Wednesday raided Kamwenje and Matwiku areas of Laikipia County and made away with over 30 head of cattle
- More than 30 residential houses were on Thursday afternoon gutted after a fire broke out at Kamakwa area of Nyeri County
- A girl on Thursday died after their three-bedroom house at Chaani in Mombasa County was razed to the ground following a fire outbreak

- Suspected burglars are alleged to have on Friday stole Sh1.5 million from a Micro Finance bank in Kitui County
- Three National Police reservists were on Friday abducted by suspected Al Shabaab militants at Qorof Harer village in Wajir County
- Seven Administration Police Officers were on Saturday killed after their vehicle ran over an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) at Konton in Wajir County
- Police in Siaya County are pursuing a 25-year-old man who is suspected to have on Saturday killed his mother at Kaduor village over a land dispute
- More than 80 students on Sunday evening lost personal belongings in a fire outbreak at Rangala Girls' High School in Siaya County
- A man was arrested following the Sunday killing of a pregnant woman in Mukaa, Makueni County

- Security agencies on Monday profiled and arrested three suspects spotted on CCTV breaking into vehicles parked outside Gateway Mall along the Mombasa Road, Machakos County
- Police on Monday arrested two Egyptians suspected of engaging in business illegally at Kiminini Township, Trans Nzoia County
