

# WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

## INTRODUCTION

The Directorate of Criminal Investigations (DCI) has rolled out a countrywide transfer plan of more than 120 of its junior and mid-level police officers, a move directed towards restoring the public's trust following complaints on the number of collapsed court cases resulting from shoddy investigations by the officers.

Further calls for police officers transfers also rocked West Pokot County following increased cases of extrajudicial killings, abductions, and deteriorating insecurity in the region. The latest incident is the murder of former Kapyegoh Member of County Assembly whose body was found dumped in Kamatira forest.




## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI


The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- Detectives in Nairobi are looking for a man who on Tuesday night torched two houses at Mukuru Kayaba after learning that his estranged wife was living with another man.
- A police constable based at Langata Police Station was on Thursday night found lying unconscious by the road in South C after he was allegedly drugged and robbed by unknown people.
- An M-Pesa agent was on Thursday robbed of ATM cards and five mobile phones at gun point in Langata, Nairobi.
- A key suspect behind the drugging of passengers was on Friday night arrested by Easy Coach Security team at their Nairobi's CBD booking offices.
- A security guard is suspected to have on Saturday killed his colleague guarding a private home in Gigiri area, Nairobi.
- The body of a policeman was on Sunday found hanging in the bathroom of his house in Dandora, Nairobi.
- Sixteen people were on Monday arrested after police raided a site in Industrial Area, Nairobi County, in connection with fuel adulteration.




Two police officers were drugged and robbed by unknown people in two separate incidents



## ANALYSIS OF CRIME INCIDENTS IN KENYA








There was a slight increase in the number of incidents reported in public places in comparison to the previous week


## AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

## BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS




- A 16-year-old student of Gachanka Secondary School was on Tuesday allegedly defiled, murdered and her body dumped in a maize plantation at Kamatoo village in Meru County.
- Three suspects were on Tuesday night nabbed stealing the newly installed street lights in two separate locations of Karibaribi and Gatuanyaga, Kiambu County.
- Security officers in Nakuru
   County on Wednesday arrested
   12 suspected members of the deadly "Confirm" gang that had been terrorising members of the public.
- Police in Kisumu are investigating the circumstances under which a 27-year-old University Student was on Wednesday killed and his body dumped outside Kisumu Muslim Cemetery.
- Kirinyaga Police officers rescued a 15-year-old Secondary schoolgirl from a house in Kiandai village of Gichugu Constituency after

- she was on Thursday allegedly abducted by a boda boda rider.
- Suspected bandits on Thursday killed one person and made away with 25 cows after raiding Chesegon area of West Pokot County.
- A 42-year-old father of three on Friday committed suicide at his shop in Matungulu village of Machakos County under unknown circumstances.
- Three Al Shabaab militants were on Friday night killed by police during a raid at a Border Patrol Unit in Garissa County.
- The body of a former Member of Elgeyo Marakwet County Assembly was on Saturday found dumped in Kamatira Forest, West Pokot County after he was allegedly abducted from his shop in Hawaii Estate on the outskirts of Eldoret town.
- Five suspects were on Saturday arrested while attempting to sell a stolen car in Nyeri County.

- A form four student was on Sunday arrested after she allegedly stabbed to death a class eight pupil in a row over a boyfriend in Khayega, Kakamega County.
- A woman was on Sunday stabbed and killed by her neighbour after an argument at Nyandiwa trading centre in Suba, Homa Bay County.
- Police in Murang'a County on Monday arrested a man who was found in possession of bhang worth Ksh 500,000 in Mathioya.
- The body of a 48-year-old woman was on Monday found hanging from a tree near Comboni Polytechnic in Gilgil, Nakuru County.
