INTRODUCTION

The Country remains on high alert over a possible terror attack following the arrest of four suspects posing as customers at two high-end hotels within Nairobi and the suspension of public transport in Mandera County.

Other than the above, police in Mombasa over the weekend gunned down one of the most wanted criminals in the area after hunting him down for months. Statistics on criminal gangs in Mombasa shows that Wakili Kwanza, Wakali Wao, Wajukuu Wa Bibi, and Congo are the leading gangs among the 42 juvenile gangs that have been inflicting injuries to residents despite security officials improving the situation and promising to take more actions.





HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- Three casual labourers are accused to have on Tuesday stole household items after sneaking into the house of a businessman in Karen's Hardy area.
- Two male suspects were on Tuesday arrested at the Hilton Hotel after they were caught engaging in suspicious activities shortly after placing their orders.
- Small traders on Thursday engaged police in running battles as they demonstrated the demolitions of makeshift structures on the Roysambu-Kasarani area in Nairobi.
- DCI detectives on Friday arrested two suspects for robbing customers who use banks situated inside two shopping malls namely Garden City Mall and Thika Road Mall.
- Two Safaricom employees were arrested for data theft that occurred on Friday at Safaricom Care Centre in Westlands, Nairobi.
- Property of unknown value was on Saturday destroyed after a fire broke out in Kibra area of Nairobi.
- An armed University Student was on Monday afternoon shot and injured by police officers after he reportedly jumped over the State House fence in Nairobi.






AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS




- Police are investigating an incident where a man is suspected to have on Tuesday committed suicide after killing his wife at Mawe Tatu in Likuyani, Kakamega County

- The body of a police officer was on Friday evening found hanging on a tree near a quarry at Katine village in Matungulu, Machakos County
- A 21-year-old man was on Saturday evening caught pants down with a Form Three student in a Kitengela lodge, Kajiado County
- A Mandera-based police officer on Saturday committed suicide under unknown circumstances
