


HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI


The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- A thief was on Tuesday evening caught breaking into parked cars at MP Shah Hospital, Nairobi.
- Property of unknown value was on Tuesday evening destroyed by a fire at a club in Kasarani estate, Nairobi.
- Two thugs were on Wednesday shot dead in a shootout with police in Kayole after a botched robbery.
- A woman on Thursday sustained serious burns while her two children were rescued during a night fire that left 18 household homeless in Mukuru Kayaba slums.
- Suspected armed robbers on Thursday stole a vehicle from a residential house along Hamisi Road in Kileleshwa.
- A 37-year-old Tanzania national was on Thursday arrested at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for being in possession of about 4 kilos of heroin before boarding a plane to India.
- One robbery with violence suspect was on Monday arrested and a stolen motor vehicle recovered following an operation by Special Crime Police Unit at Umoja 1 in Buruburu.



Unlike the previous times, this week saw religious institutes recorded two key incidents-inferno and armed robbery.


AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS




- A woman operating as an M-Pesa agent was on Tuesday shot and robbed on her way to bank in Mombasa County.
- A 15-year-old student on Tuesday night committed suicide at Longonot trading centre in Naivasha, Nakuru County.
- A KCPE candidate who went missing on Wednesday morning was found murdered and her body dumped in a maize plantation at Malela village, Homa Bay County.
- A suspected criminal was on Wednesday shot and killed after attacking police with this gun in Jomvu, Mombasa County.
- One person was on Thursday injured and rushed to hospital after suspected highway bandits attacked a Red Cross vehicle on the Lokichar-Kainuk road in Turkana County.
- A senior police officer was on Thursday found murdered inside his rental house in Cheptais area, Bungoma County.

- Two suspected gunmen on Friday night shot dead a fifth year Kenyatta University student at his girlfriend's house in Kahawa Wendani, Kiambu County.
- A middle woman from Kirinyaga County was on Friday kidnapped by unknown people in between Kenya Commercial Bank and St. Michael Girls Secondary School in Kerugoya town.
- Police in Nakuru County are investigating an incident where suspected robbers on Saturday carjacked an elderly man and killed him before escaping in his vehicle at Mirera centre.
- A suspected member of the dreaded Wakali Kwanza terror gang was on Saturday lynched in Likoni while two of his accomplices escaped.
- Police in Mandera County arrested a man who on Sunday morning allegedly stabbed and killed his wife at their home in Bula Jamhuri area.
- A couple and their child on Sunday perished in a fire that

- razed down their wooden house in Nyandarua County.
- A 51-year-old woman was on Monday found stabbed to death with a kitchen knife by unknown assailants at Kirobon farm, Nakuru County.
- Armed thugs on Monday morning raided a church in Kiboswa area, Kisumu County, and made away with Ksh1.6 million meant for elderly persons.
