



# WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

## INTRODUCTION

The intensified crackdown on criminals across the Country saw police officers in Nairobi County gun down at least five armed thugs in two separate locations.

Similarly, the security agencies in Nakuru County were able to seize a wanted ringleader of a criminal gang known as “Confirm” at his hideout in Bondeni slum. The Confirm criminal gang has for the past three weeks terrorized members of the public in Kivumbini, Flamingo, Kisulisuli, Kaloleni, Bondeni, and Lake View Estates.

Despite the above, there is a rising concern regarding the number of suicide cases reported across the Country. Since the start of this month, our security record indicates a slight upsurge in the number of individuals who took their own life under unclear circumstances.



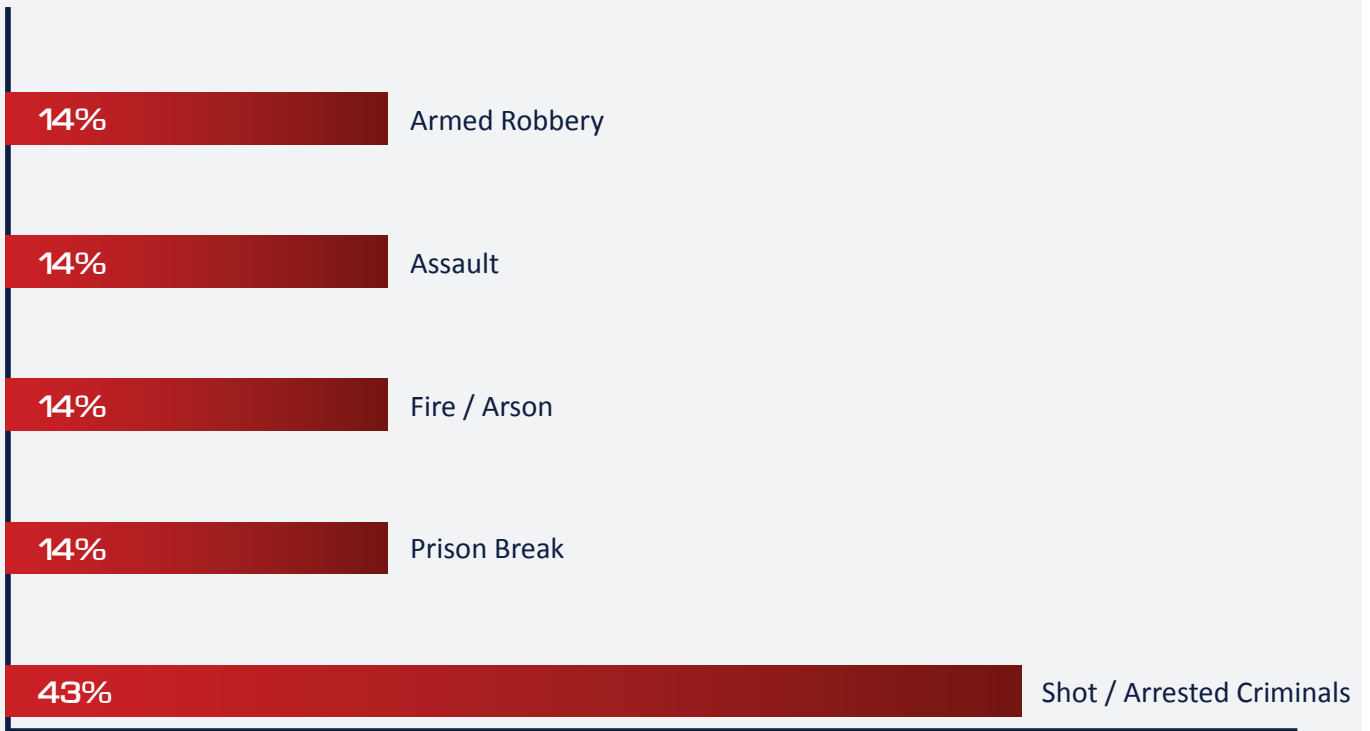
## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- More than 100 household structures were on Tuesday burnt down in Nairobi slum, leaving some families out in the cold.
- Two suspected thugs were on Tuesday shot dead along Waiyaki Way in Nairobi County following reports of robbery activities.
- One suspect was on Wednesday arrested with six rounds of ammunition at Nairobi’s Kayole following a tip off from the public.
- Three armed thugs were on Friday shot dead in Marurui area of Nairobi County after a dangerous confrontation with police.
- 14 hardcore criminal suspects were on Friday reported to have escaped from a moving prison van while on transit to Industrial Area Remand Prison, Nairobi.
- DCI detectives on Thursday arrested one suspect with two pieces of elephant tusks at his home in Huruma, Nairobi.
- A 15-year-old Form Two student at the Nairobi School was on Friday allegedly assaulted brutally by School Perfects to the extent of suffering brain damage.

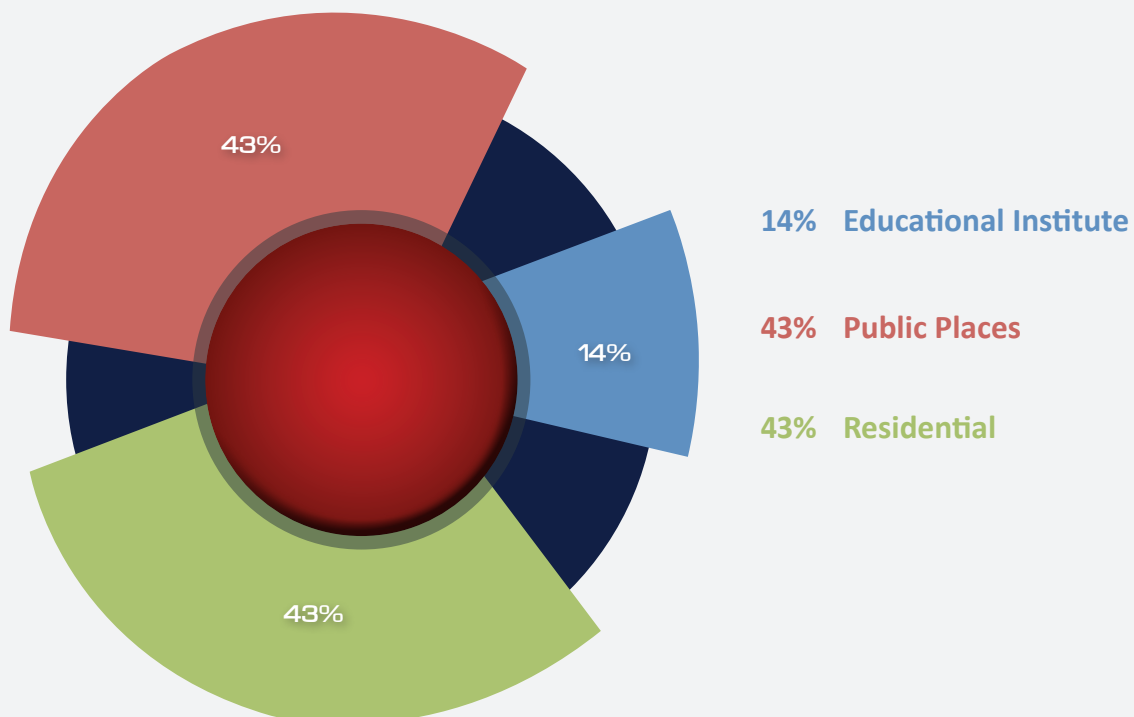

*The slight increase in fire cases in slum areas within Nairobi was of great concern*

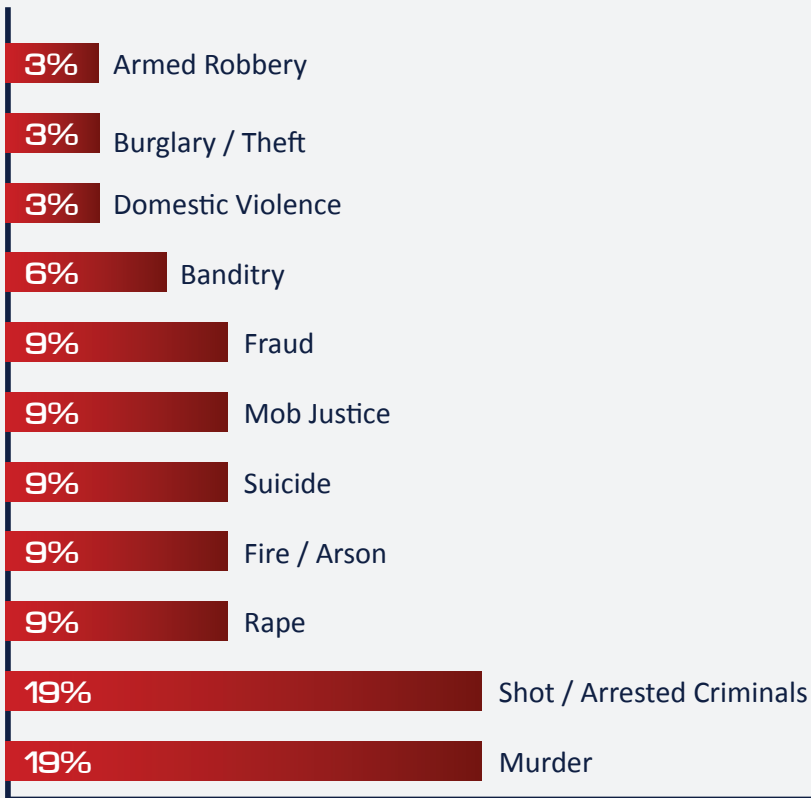
## SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



*The concern of school bully cases became known following an incident reported at Nairobi School*

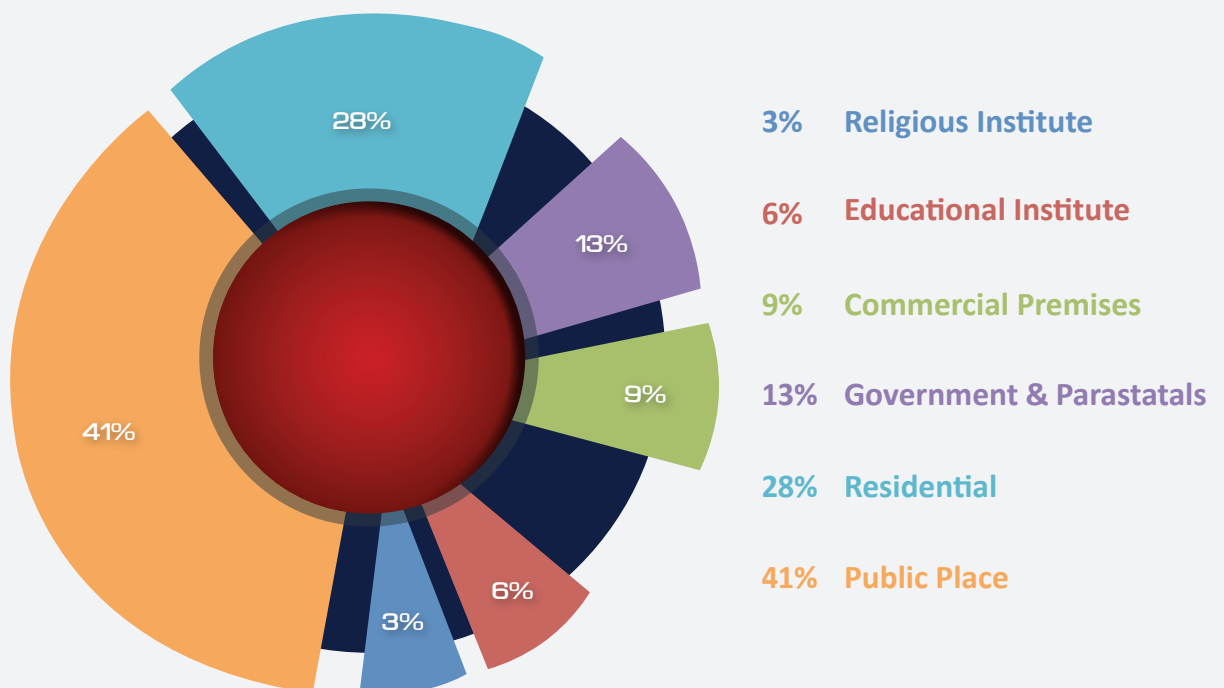

*A total of 32 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country*

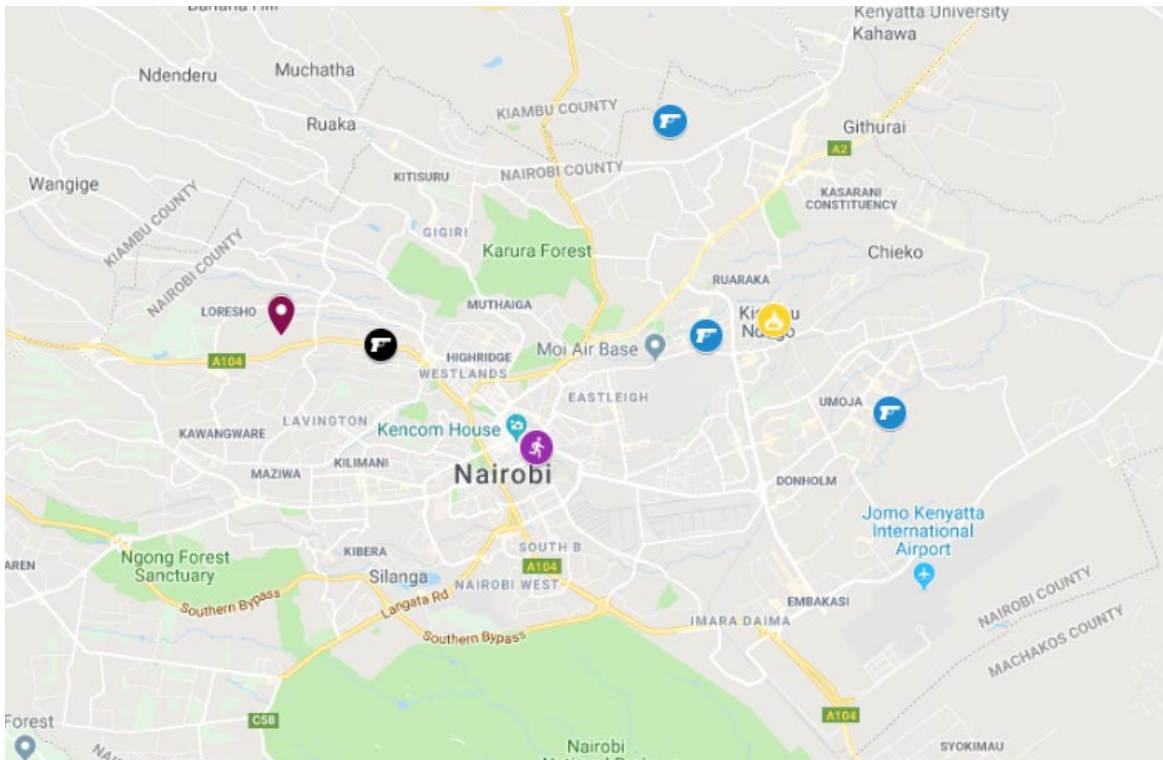
## SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS

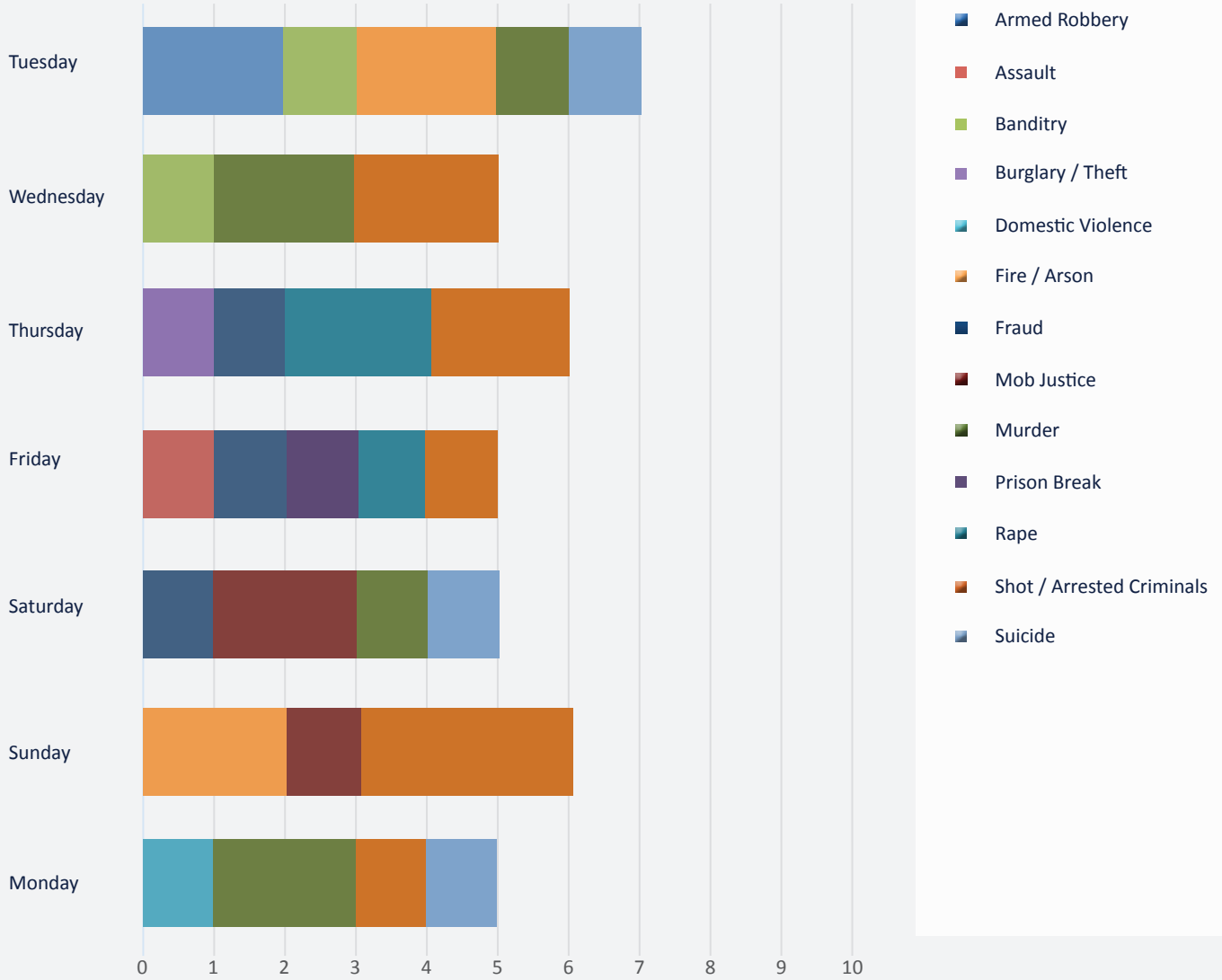

# BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- Two groups of heavily armed bandits on Tuesday afternoon attacked the Anti-Stock Theft Unit Camp in Chesongoch and a village in Ketut in Elgeyo Marakwet County.
- A night guard at a local bar at Runyenjes in Embu County was on Tuesday morning attacked and seriously injured by unknown assailants.
- An Administration Police officer was on Wednesday found murdered and his lifeless body dumped on the roadside along the Londiani-Muhoroni road in Kericho County.
- A 45-year-old man wanted for murder committed suicide on Wednesday using a belt at Magombani village in Kwale County.
- Police in Homa Bay County on Thursday arrested three suspected criminals and recovered a home-made pistol, following a raid at their hideout at Koginga Beach.
- Police officers in Kilifi County on Thursday arrested a man who had briefly kidnapped and allegedly sodomised a two year old girl in Chumani area.
- The Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) officials on Friday seized 144 drums of ethanol which had been declared as 1,000 bags of cement at the Port of Mombasa.
- A police officer was on Friday arrested on accusation of defiling a 15-year-old girl at Konoin constituency, Bomet County.
- A suspected drunk man on Saturday hacked to death a Class Eight pupil at Matulo ward of Bungoma County.
- Two suspected thieves were on Saturday lynched at Cheboin area of Bomet County after they were caught by the public.
- Police in Siaya County on Sunday arrested six students of Usenge High School in possession of a jerry can of petrol and a matchbox in a suspected mission to burn the school.
- A man was on Sunday arrested in Baragoi area of Samburu County on suspicion of planning to carry out a terror attack at a local church.
- A wanted ring leader of a criminal gang in Nakuru County known as “Confirm” was on Monday arrested at his hideout in Bondeni slum.
- Police in Kilgoris are hunting for a woman suspected to have on Monday evening killed her husband following a domestic quarrel at their home in Nkararo village, Narok County.
