



WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

13th August - 19th August '19

OVERVIEW

Police continued to intensify security across the country in readiness for the sixth National Census on the night of August 24 to August 31, 2019. This exercise will require people to open their doors for the Kenya National Bureau of Statistics (KNBS) enumerators but after validating their credentials to prevent falling victim to criminals.

Other than the above, there was a notable concern of an organized gang responsible for hijacking and killing drivers around Mai Mahiu area in Naivasha Sub-County.

Motorists using the Mai Mahiu route are advised to exercise utmost precaution and be very cautious about strangers who may request for lifts. It's advisable to think twice before agreeing to play the proverbial "good Samaritan" character since the consequences could be too costly to bear!



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- Three suspected thieves on Wednesday stole an MPesa phone from a retail outlet at Ciata City mall along Kiambu road, Nairobi
- Police in Nairobi on Thursday dispersed hundreds of Kangemi residents who stormed a census enumerators training centre in protest against flawed hiring
- Five people were on Thursday night arrested with 450 bags of counterfeit sugar following a raid in Kayole, Nairobi
- An Uber driver was on Saturday robbed of his cash by suspected thugs in Langata area, Nairobi County
- Property worth millions of shillings was on Monday morning destroyed after a fire broke out at Githurai 45 furniture market next to Kassmart Supermarket along Thika Superhighway, Nairobi

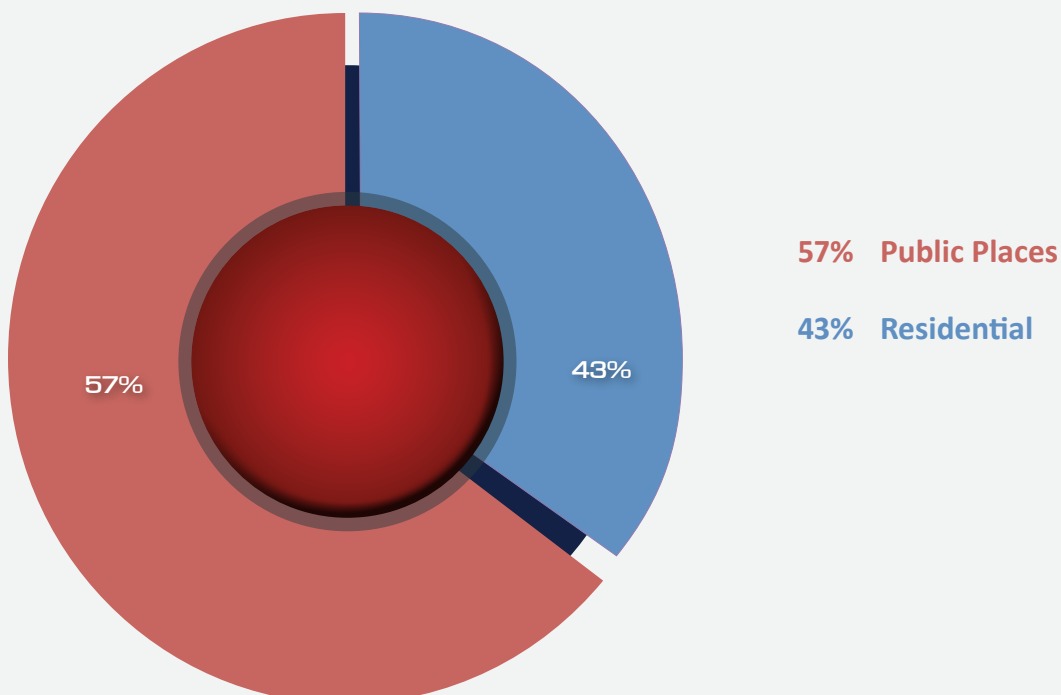

There was a notable reduction in the number of incidents reported in Nairobi

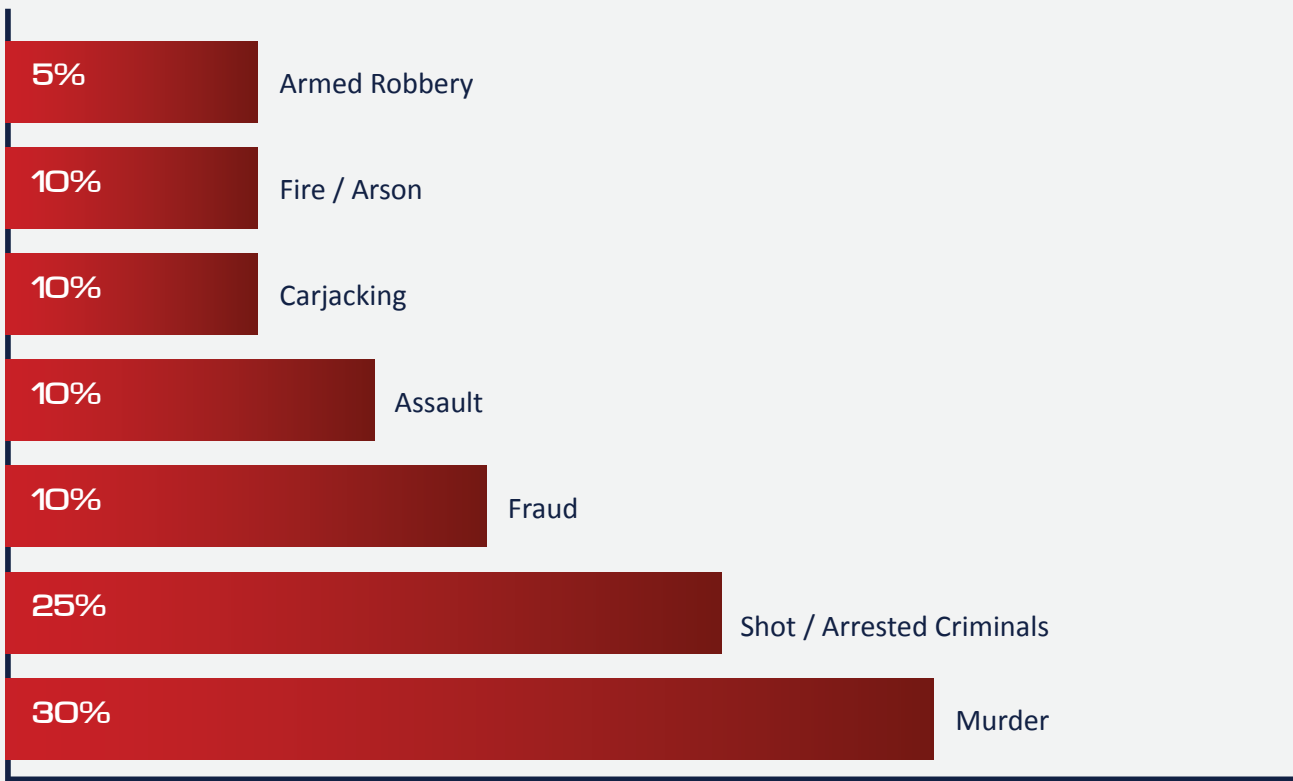
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI



There were no notable incidents reported in Residential Areas

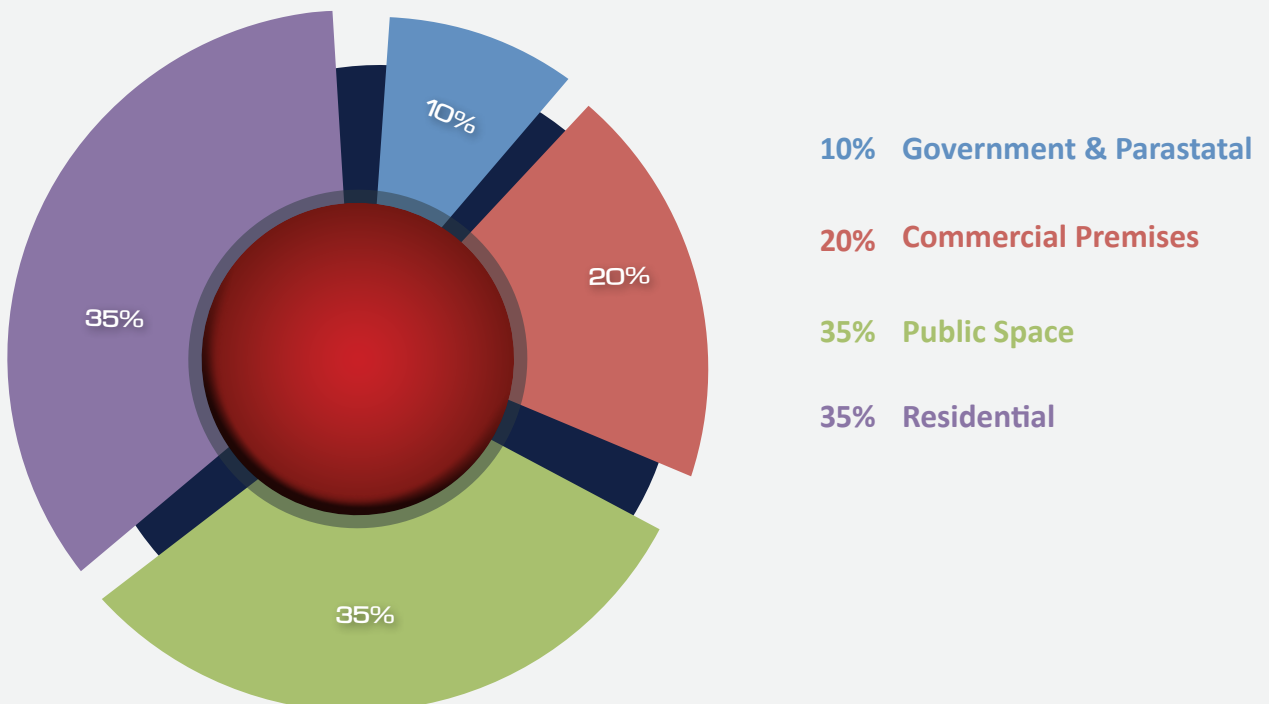

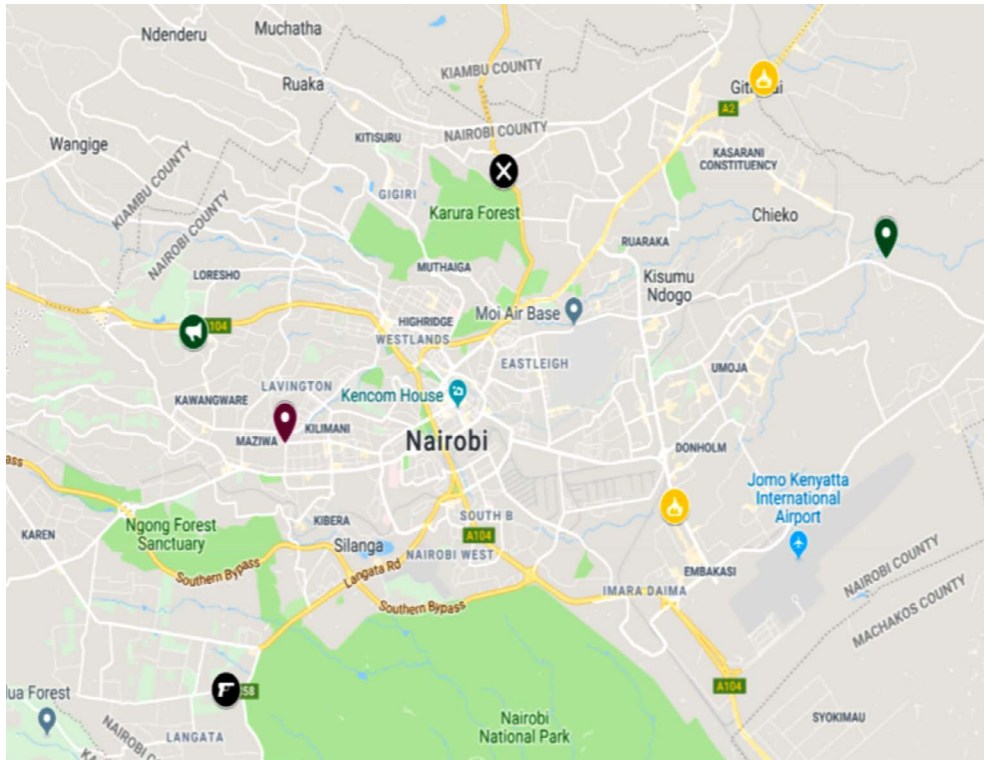
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS IN THE REST OF THE COUNTRY

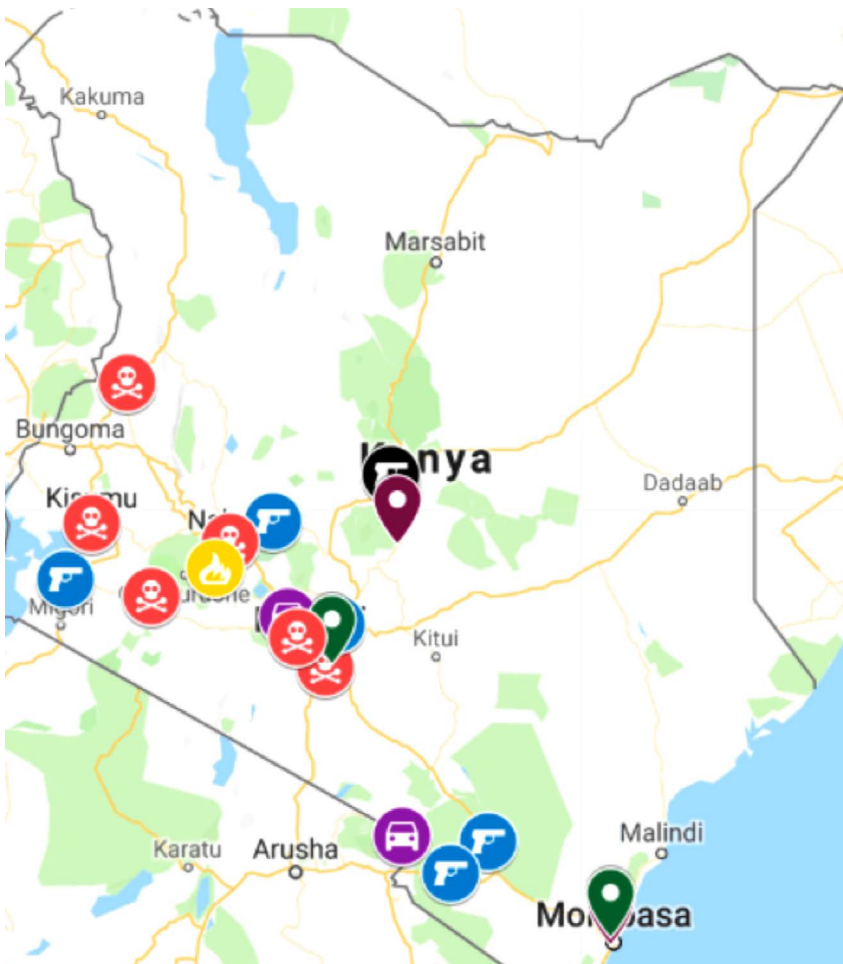

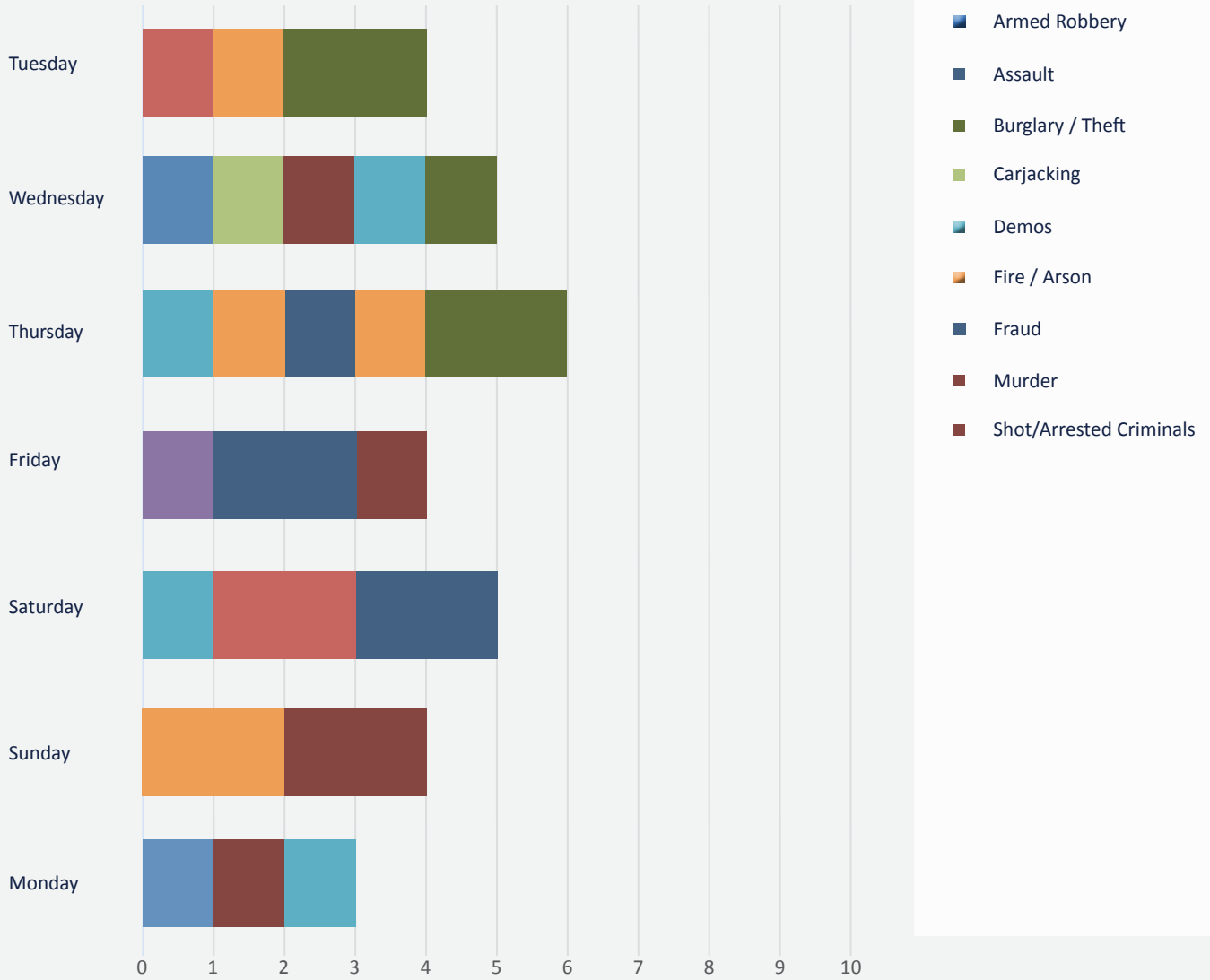

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- A fire on Tuesday gutted down two godowns at Mavoko Business Park in Athi River, Machakos County.
- Detectives on Tuesday arrested two wardens after CCTV footage showed them hiding huge amount of cocaine in a toilet at Manyani Maximum Prison in Taita Taveta County.
- A businessman was on Wednesday hacked to death by two assailants inside his video shop in Kitengela town, Kajiado County.
- A six-man gang on Wednesday night shot a shopkeeper and later beat a 25-year-old man during a robbery incident at a store near Pepo la Tumaini Primary School in Isiolo County.
- Three suspected criminals were on Thursday gunned down at Kogwe junction in Homa Bay County.
- A suspect of violent robberies was on Thursday arrested by Special Crime Prevention Unit along the Thika-Garissa highway, Kiambu County.
- One person was on Friday night arrested and stolen sugar recovered from a house in Bangladesh estate, Mombasa County.
- A driver was on Friday murdered and his vehicle stolen by two alleged customers at Mai Mahiu area, Nakuru County.
- A businessman was on Saturday morning attacked and killed by unknown assailants at his Industrial Area-based factory, Nakuru County.
- A hotel manager is alleged to have on Saturday morning shot dead a bus driver following an argument over parking space at Polyview Estate in Kisumu County.
- A man on Sunday morning hacked his wife to death and then hanged himself at their home in Makunga village, Trans Nzoia County.
- A prison warder attached to Bomet GK prison is alleged to have on Monday night killed his girlfriend after a quarrel at Kamukunji estate, Bomet County.
