20th August - 25th August '19

OVERVIEW

The final week of August 2019 recorded a slight increase in the number of crime-related incidents in comparison to the previous week.

Among the documented security incidents, there was a concern regarding the safety of the Census Enumerators following notable attacks in Kisumu, Kilifi, and Marsabit Counties. Our security sources further indicate cases of bandit attacks in North Rift regions, where the total number of casualties were at least 12.

Despite all these, the security agencies are working to restore the state of normalcy in the Country.




HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI


The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- A man is accused to have on Tuesday strangled his one-month-old son to death after quarrelling with his wife at Kayole, Nairobi.
- Police in Nairobi arrested three suspects accused of defrauding a couple of Ksh.2 million for the sale of a piece of land in Red Hill Garden area.
- Machakos County Government's Communication officer was on Sunday morning abducted by unknown people in Nairobi's Central Business District.
- Two robbers were on Monday evening gunned down at Kiamaiko area of Nairobi County by undercover detectives who responded to a distress call by members of public in attempted robbery incident .





Notable reduction of crime incidents were recorded in Nairobi




AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS




- Police in Vihiga County are holding a 45-year-old man who on Tuesday allegedly killed his brother after an argument at Mang'unyuli village in Sabatia.
- DCI detectives based in Imenti North, Meru County on Tuesday arrested one suspect and recovered a vehicle that had been reported stolen.
- At least 20 families were on Wednesday night left homeless after a fire razed down houses at Maua in Meru County.
- Suspected criminals on Wednesday night broke into Samburu County Assembly offices in Maralal.
- A legislator and Census enumerators were on Thursday attacked by unknown gunmen at Masalale area of Wajir County during a Census sensitisation exercise.
- A boda boda rider was on Thursday shot dead and a trader robbed of Sh.200,000 when gangsters raided Gikuuri market in Mbeere, Meru County.

- Police on Friday arrested two armed robbers who had been terrorising residents and investors in Kitengela, Kajiado County.
- An Anti-Stock Theft police officer was on Friday shot and injured by suspected bandits who raided Wangwachi area of Laikipia County.
- A Census enumerator in Kisumu County was on Saturday night defiled by a gang while on her way home in Maseno.
- Three fishermen were arrested for allegedly defiling a 48-yearold woman at Rang'wa location in Suba South, Homa Bay County.
- Two houses belonging to the Kenya Railways were on Sunday razed under unclear circumstances in Kisumu County.
- At least 10 people were on Sunday killed and over 1500 livestock stolen by suspected bandits who raided Forole area in Marsabit County.
