OVERVIEW

As a majority of schools continue to reopen after a lengthy holiday session, it is prudent for parents to track the movements of their children reporting to boarding schools.

Similar periods in the past years have been marked with instances of students either getting mugged, drugged or kidnapped thereby failing to safely arrive to their corresponding institutions. It is further advisable for parents and guardians to liaise with the school administrators to confirm students' arrival and raise alarm in case of eventuality.

Aside from the above, officers from the Directorate of Criminal Investigations managed to arrest three suspects of car theft syndicate in Nairobi. Reports indicate that police accused the trio of drugging their unsuspecting victims using psychotropic drugs at nightclubs in Kasarani and Roysambu areas before executing the crime.



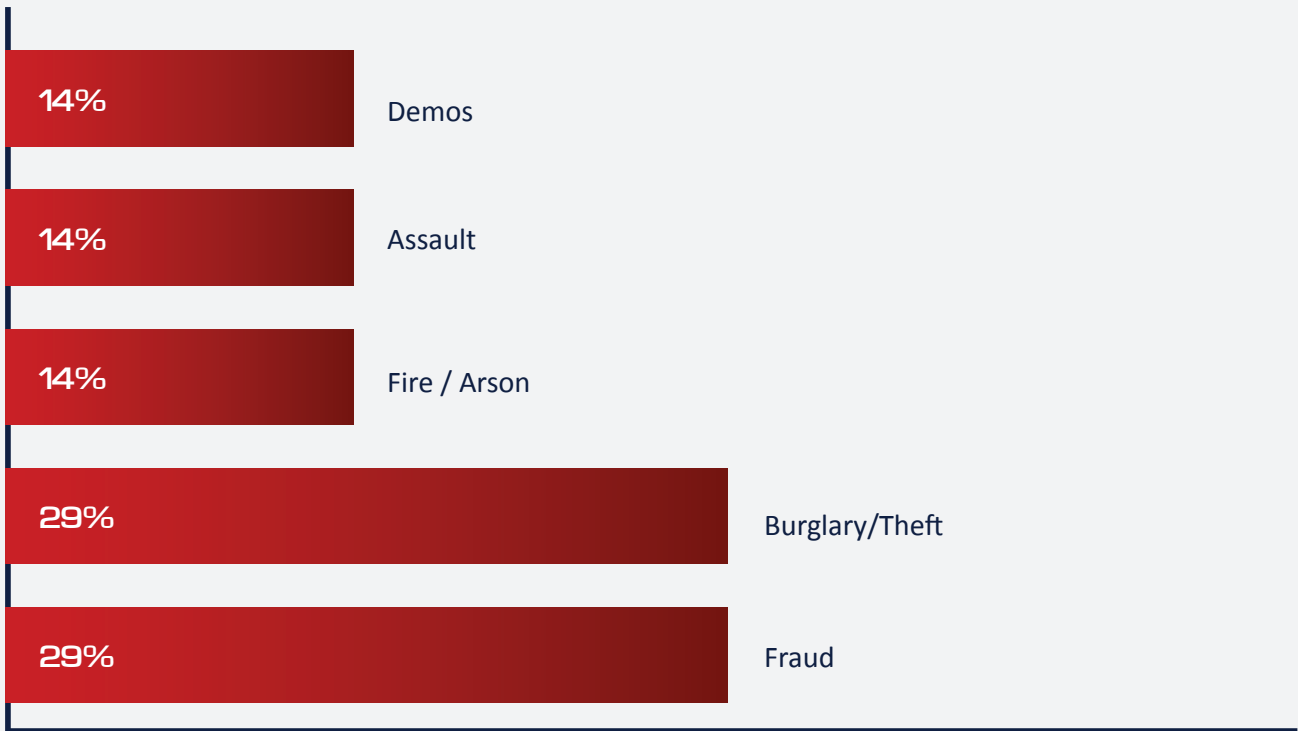
HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- A 32-year-old man was on Tuesday arrested after he allegedly impersonated a National Intelligence Service officer and demanded to speak to a suspect held at the Industrial Area Police Station, Nairobi
- A businessman who had withdrawn money from a local bank on Thursday lost some of it in a well-orchestrated robbery that was captured on surveillance camera in Nairobi's Industrial area.
- At least four people were arrested as police contained chaos that rocked outside the Kenya National Union of Teachers (KNUT) House in Nairobi County.
- Three suspects were on Saturday arrested at West View Plaza in Kahawa West. The trio are accused to be behind a car stealing syndicate in Kasarani, Nairobi.
- A box full of fake US dollars and Euros was on Sunday found by the roadside near Coptic Hospital on Ngong Road, Nairobi.
- A fire incident was on Monday night reported at Mukuru Kayaba informal settlement in Nairobi County.

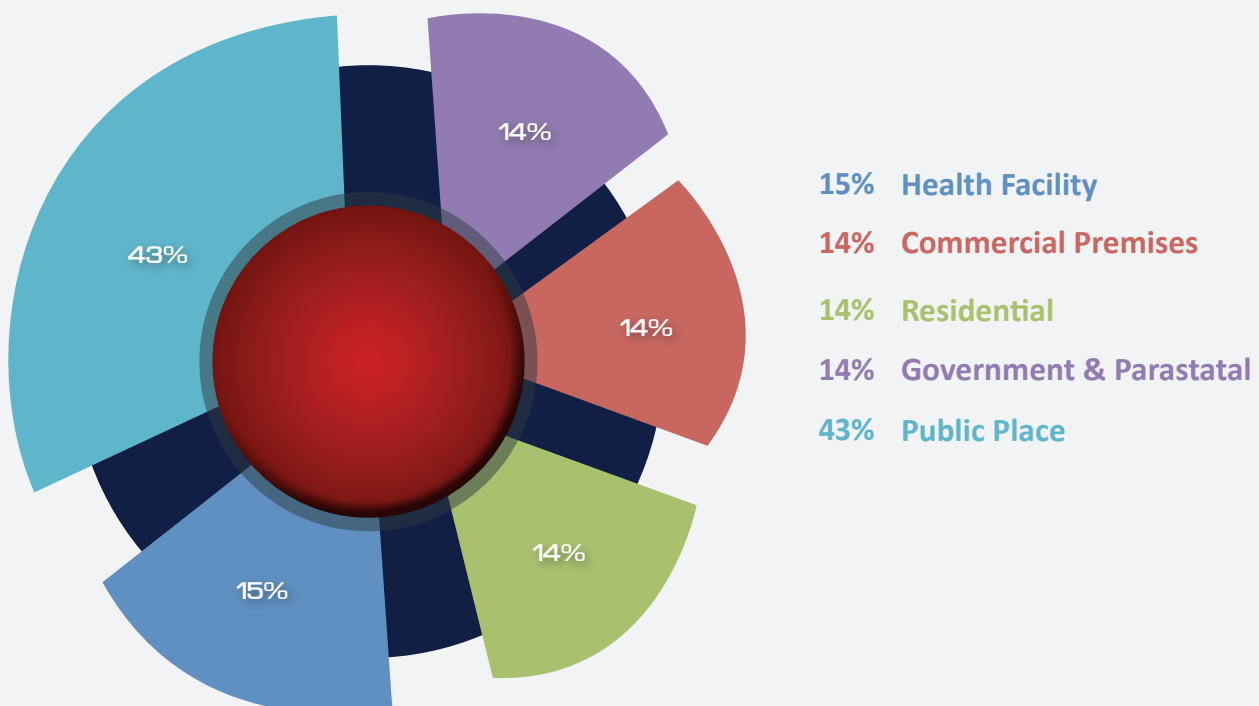

There was a notable concern of persons been robbed after withdrawing cash from local banks

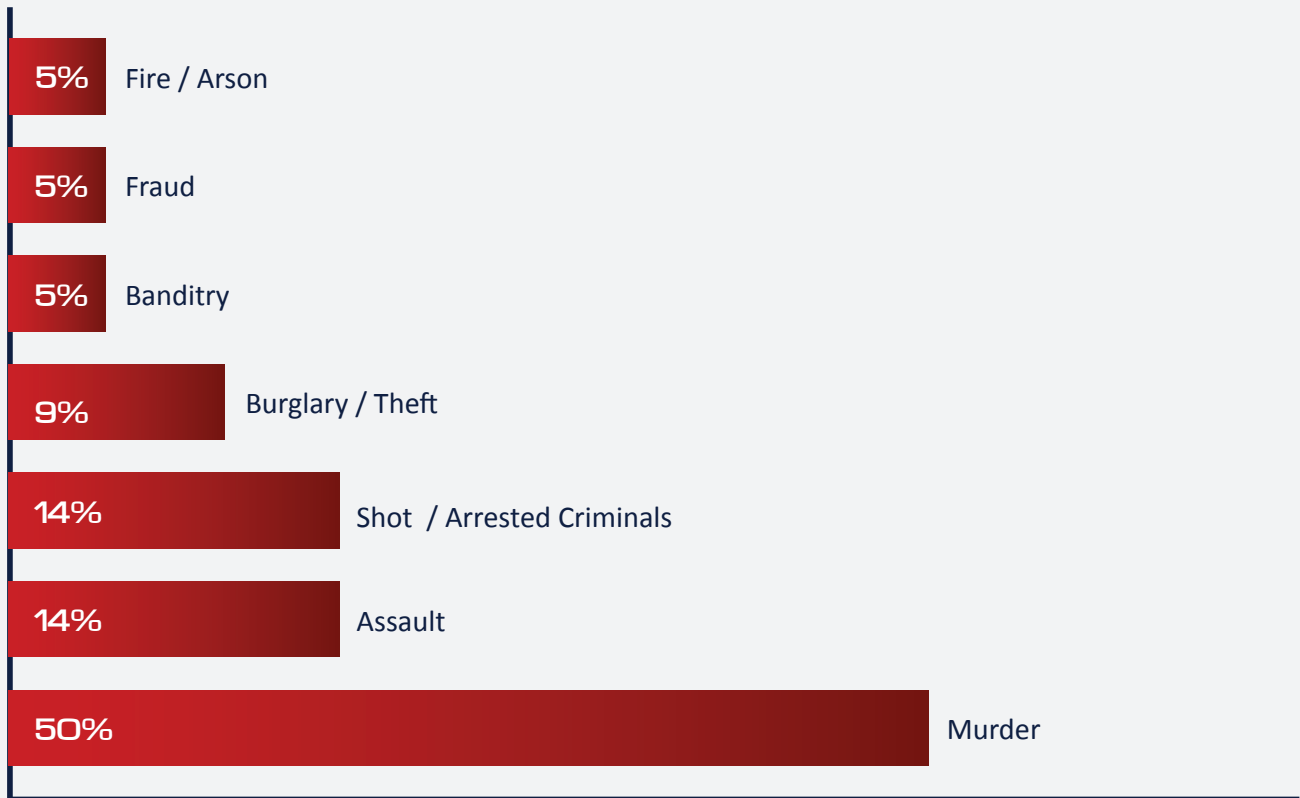
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



There was a slight increase of incidents as per the number of scene of incidents in Nairobi

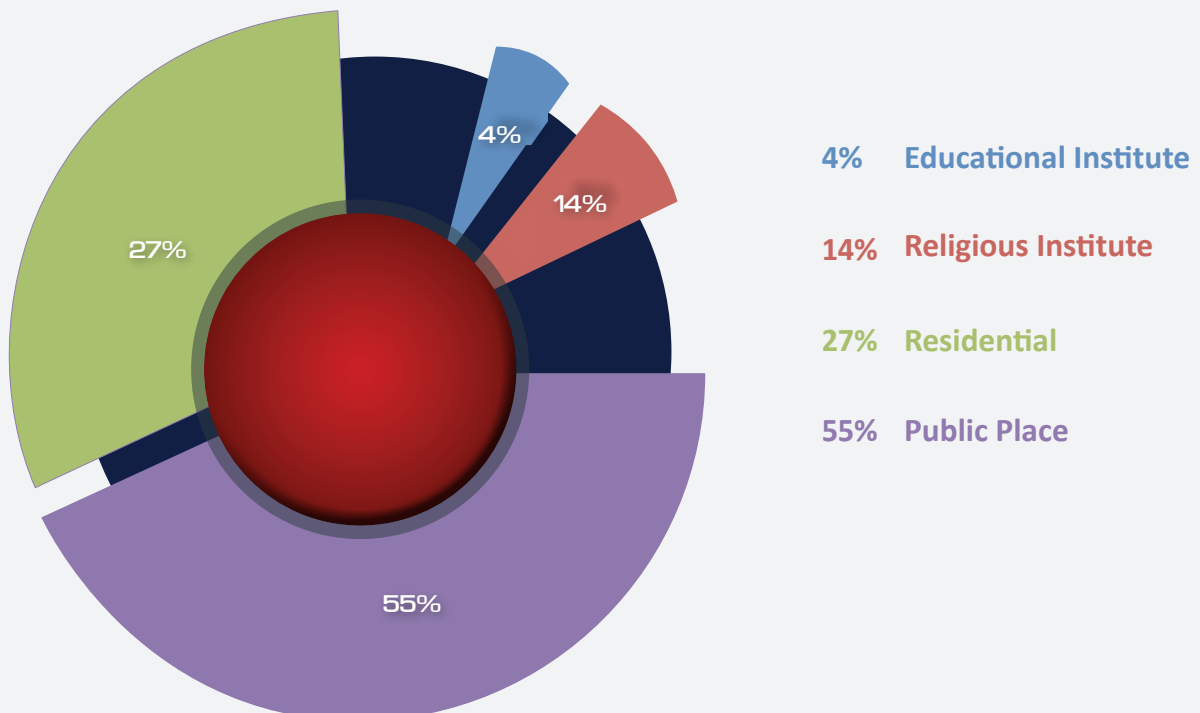

A total of 22 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country

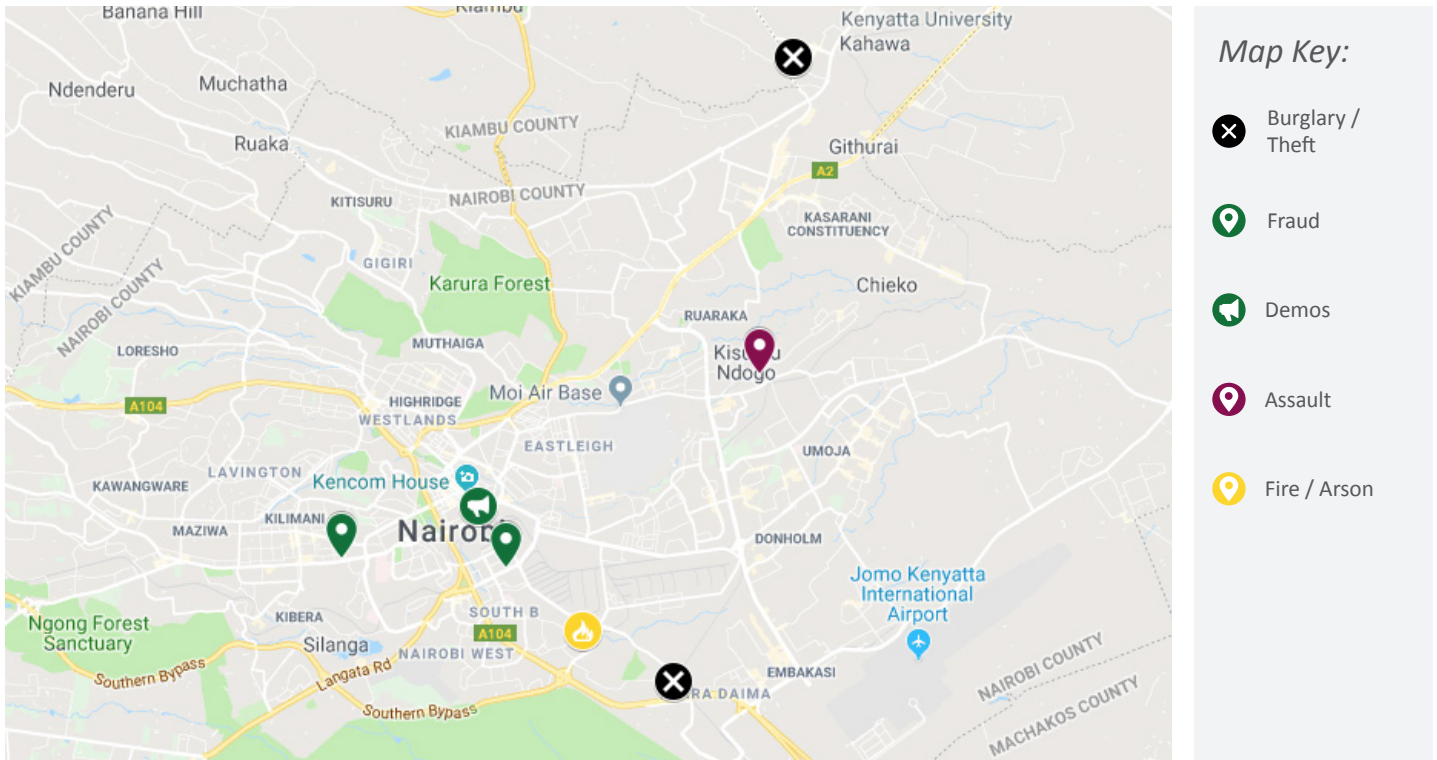
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



There was a slight increase in incidents recorded in both Residential and Public Places

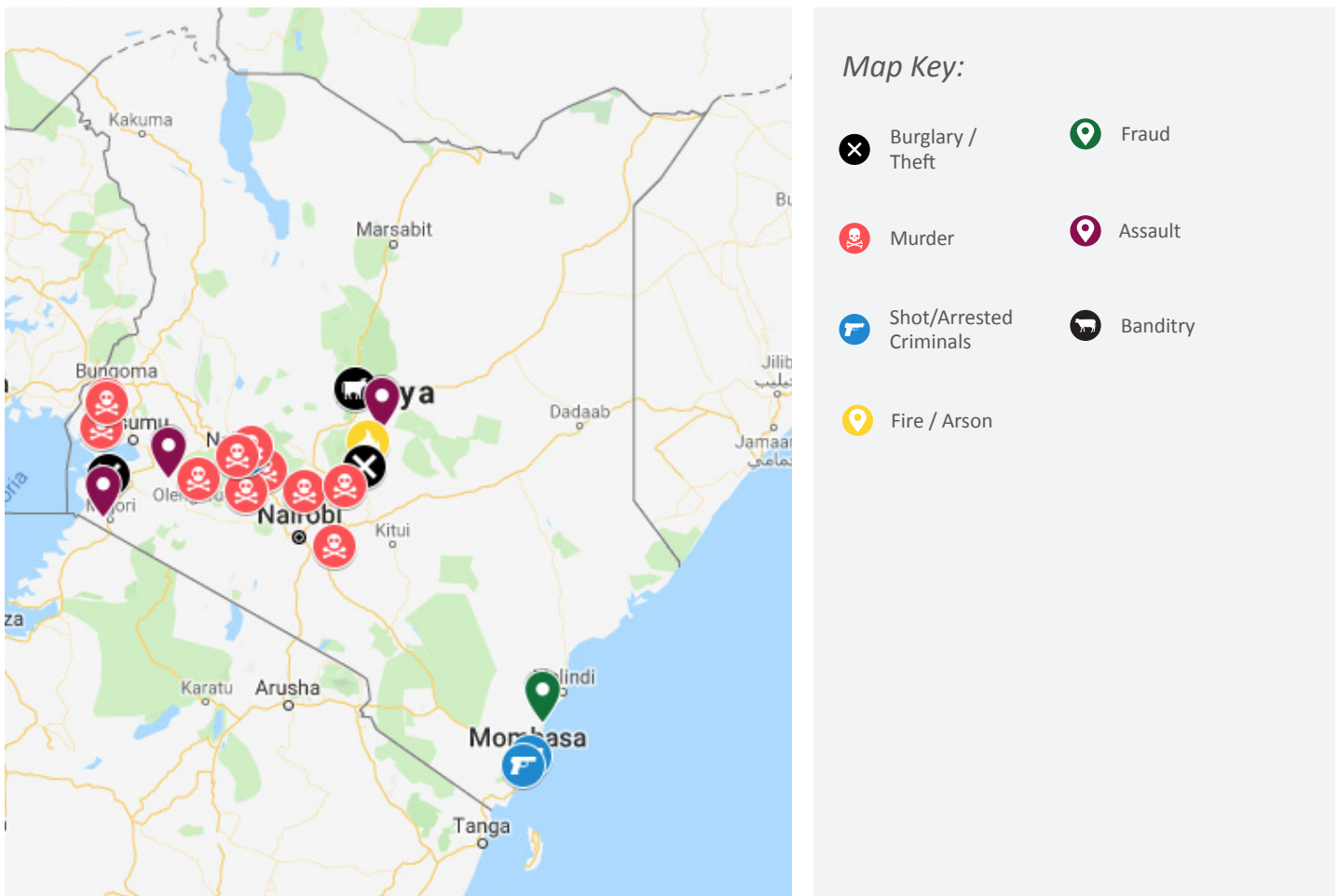
AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

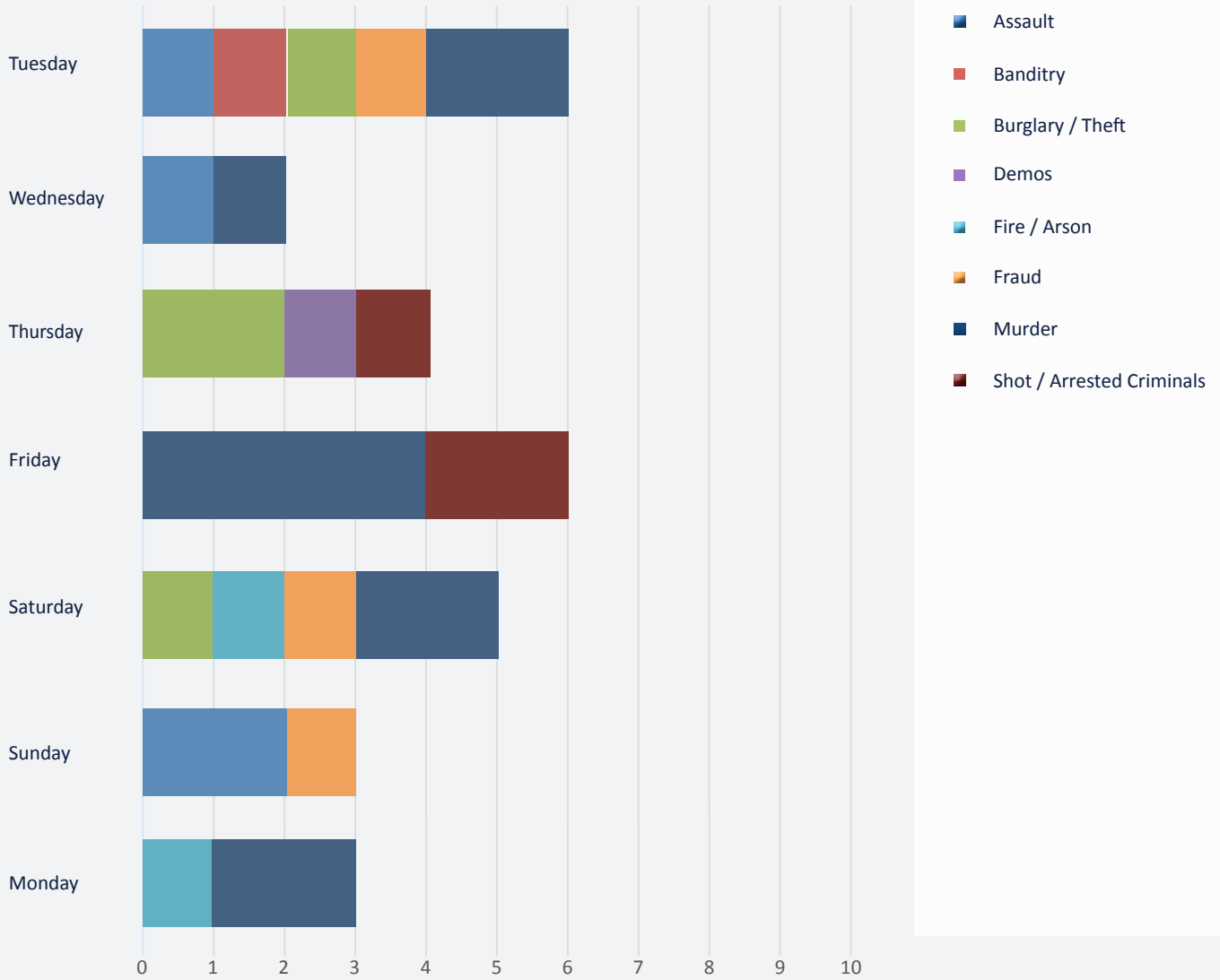

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- Police are investigating a murder incident in which the body of an activist was on Tuesday found dumped near her homestead in Muthini village, Murang'a County.
- Gangsters on Tuesday night raided Shauri Yako Primary School in Homa Bay County and stole 93 tablets, a projector, a desktop computer and a printer.
- Police in Naivasha have launched a manhunt for a group of attackers who on Wednesday shot and killed a police officer at Ndabibi area in Nakuru County.
- Four people were arrested for allegedly assaulting census enumerators on Wednesday in Kithale village, Meru County.
- Ant-terror police officers on Thursday shot and killed a suspected terrorist in Bombolulu, Mombasa County.
- A 24-year-old man was on Thursday caught stealing food from a church kitchen in Kigumo, Embu County.
- A suspected terrorist was on Friday morning killed by police in shootout in a village in Ng'ombeni, Kwale County.
- A 4-year-old girl was on Friday strangled, killed, and her body dumped in a rice farm in Mahigani village, Kirinyaga County.
- Property of unknown value was on Saturday night destroyed after a fire razed down a residential house at Ntharene market in South Imenti, Meru County.
- A 60-year-old woman and her 13-year-old nephew were on Saturday night found murdered inside their house at Umala village, Siaya County.
- A police officer was on Sunday morning injured after a mob mistaken him for a thief in Chemoiben village, Kericho County.
- Unknown persons in Migori County on Sunday raided the Legio Maria church headquarters in Got Kwer and left scores injured.
- A 35-year-old woman was on Monday morning stabbed to death by her ex-husband at Kalambya village in Kitui County.
- A 15-year-old girl was on Monday defiled and strangled to death at their home in Koyonzo, Kakamega County.
