



WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

12th November - 18th Novemebr '19

OVERVIEW

Increased security awareness from the police and the public noted a significant decrease in the number of reported crimes in the week under reference. Our security sources report of instances where the police officers were able to thwart robbery cases in Nairobi, Makueni and Mombasa Counties following reliable tip offs from the members of the public.

Despite the above, there were concerns regarding murder cases resulting from estranged relationships. In this category under review, our security sources have reported and documented at least eight cases since the start of November 2019.



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The notable incidents recorded in Nairobi included the following:

- Two suspected thugs were on Tuesday evening shot dead for allegedly terrorising residents of Lucky Summer in Nairobi
- A motor vehicle was on Wednesday morning stolen from an apartment in Tassia Estate, Nairobi.
- Police on Saturday evening shot dead two thugs while three others escaped after they hijacked a bus heading to Buru Buru from Nairobi's Central Business District.
- Unknown people on Saturday stole a motor vehicle from a parking lot near the entrance of Simba Sikh Union Club along Forest Road, Nairobi.

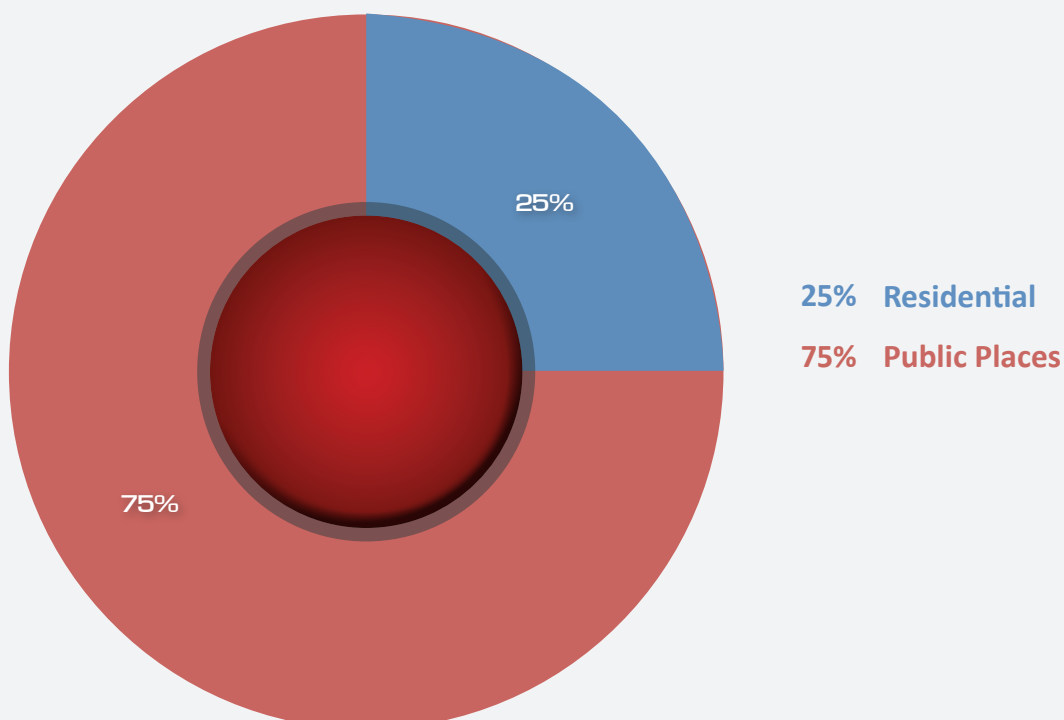

There were increased reports of motor vehicle thefts in Nairobi.

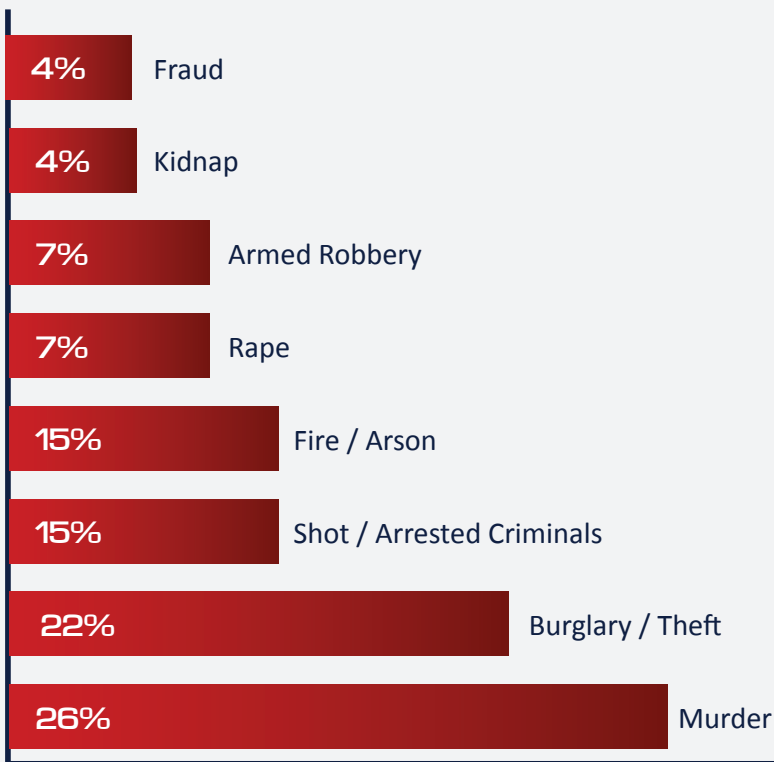
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



There was a slight reduction of incidents reported in Public Places as compared to a similar period last year

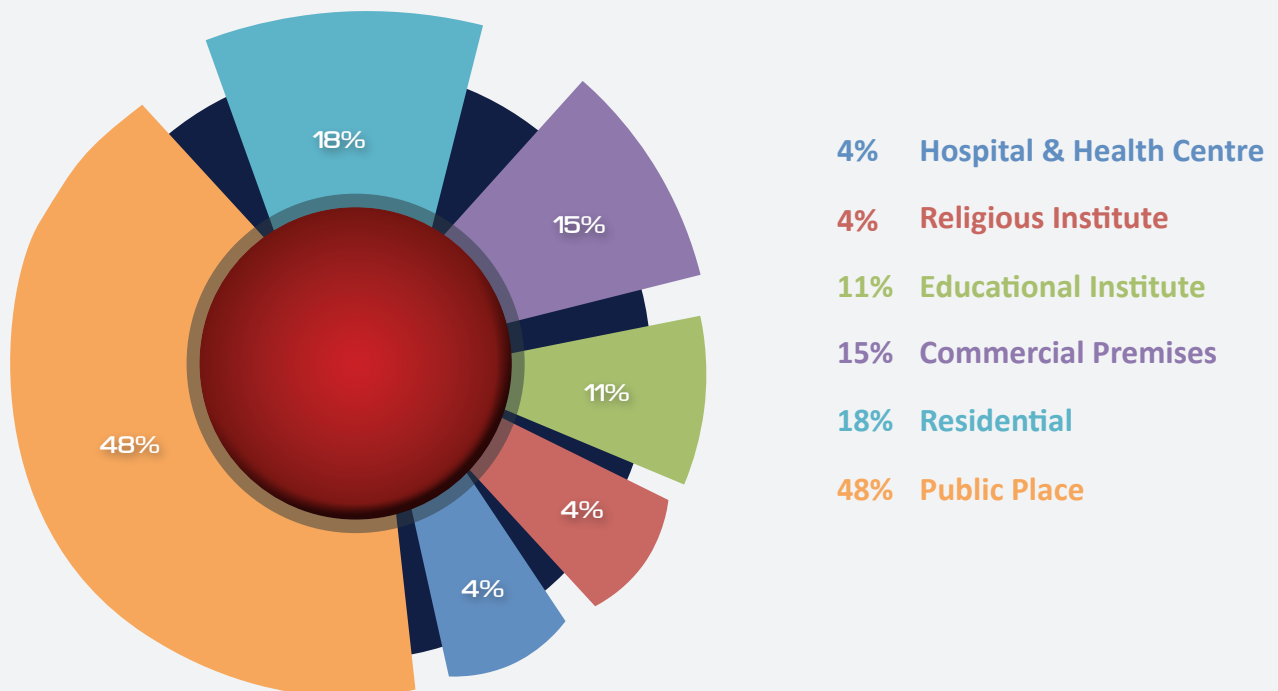

A total of 27 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country

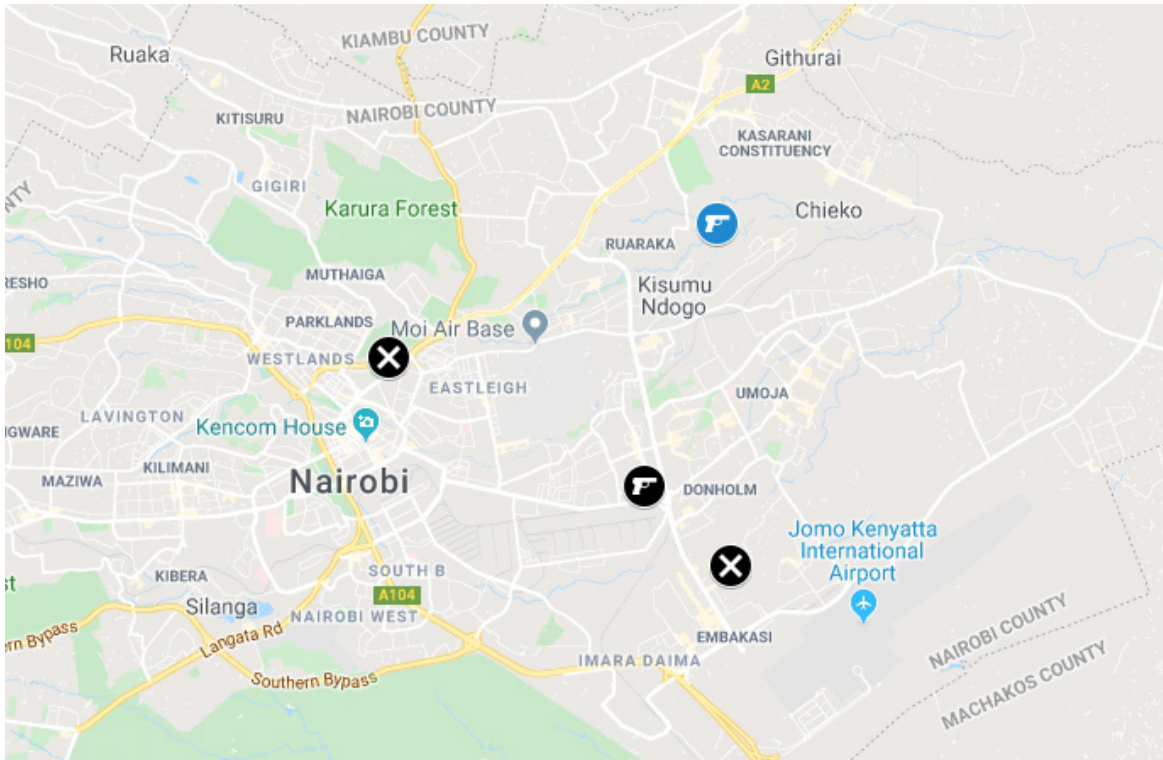
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS

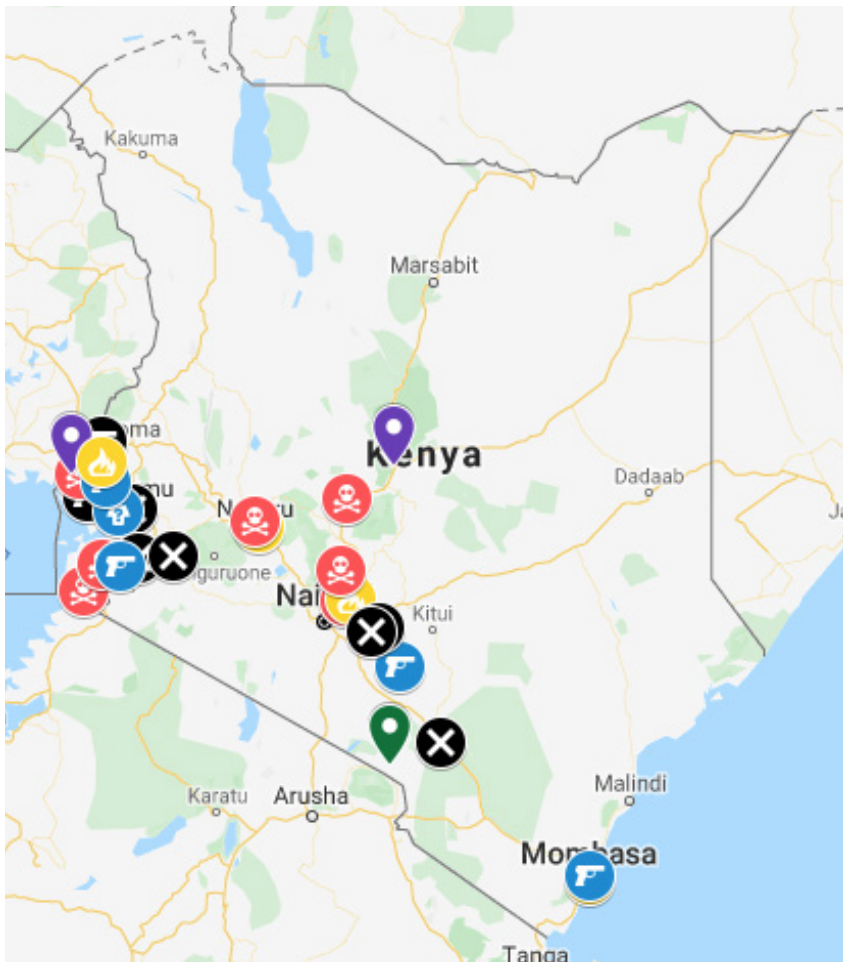

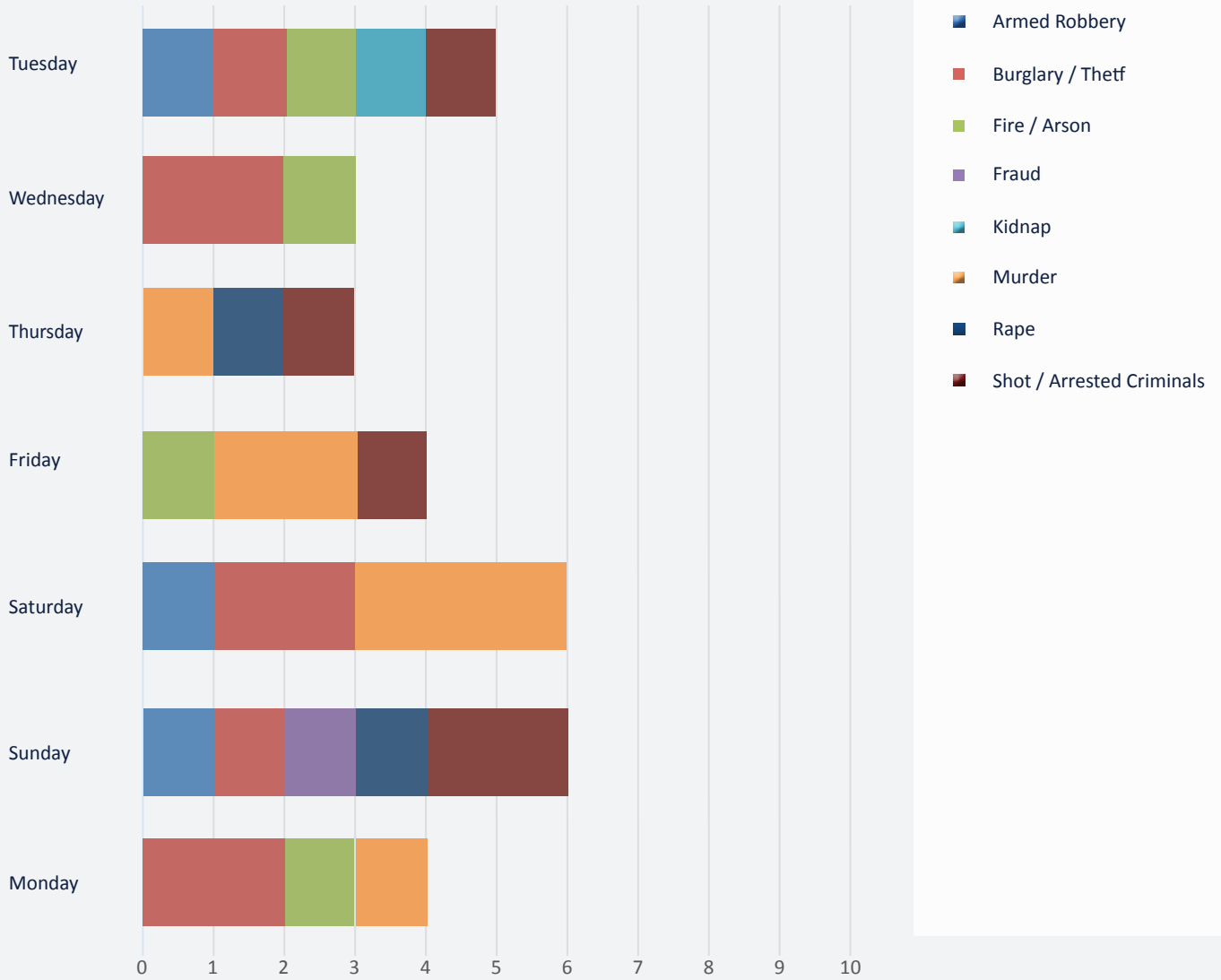

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- Property of unknown value was on Tuesday night destroyed after a fire erupted at Mombasa Hospital in Mombasa County.
- A police officer attached to the Critical Infrastructure Protection Unit in Siaya County was on Tuesday night injured and his gun stolen after he was attacked by thugs on a motorcycle.
- Three suspected thieves are accused to have on Wednesday night burgled into a home in Sengera area of Nyamira County and made away with valuables.
- A fire on Wednesday razed down some parts of Ananas Mall in Thika, Kiambu County.
- Police in Makueni County on Thursday arrested seven robbers suspected to be behind a series of thefts of electronic goods.
- A female college student was on Thursday allegedly murdered by her boyfriend at her rented room in Witeithie, Kiambu County.
- Police in Mombasa County on Friday gunned down a 15-year-old who completed KCPE last year. The boy is alleged to have been an armed criminal who with others, were terrorising residents of Mina Love area.
- A 28-year-old man is accused to have on Friday night killed his estranged wife at a lodge in Akala, Migori County.
- An unknown number of thieves on Saturday stole 14 plastic chairs and speakers after they reportedly broke into Redeemed Gospel Church in Mataka shopping centre, Machakos County.
- A primary school student was on Saturday evening killed by his classmate during a fight over a blade at Kajwang village in Ndhiwa, Homa Bay County.
- Two police officers and four civilians are accused to have on Sunday night stolen tarmal wire products from a truck that veered off the road near Kambu Police Post in Makueni County.
- Suspected thugs on Sunday allegedly shot at three people and made away with cash after raiding commercial premises at Napara market centre in Bungoma County.
- Property worth millions of shillings was on Monday morning destroyed after a fire razed down several stalls at Free Area market in Nakuru County.
- Police in Machakos County are hunting for robbers who on Monday broke into four schools and stole laptops from Mumbini Primary School in Kathiani sub-county .
