

OVERVIEW

The key incident in the week under reference happened in Mombasa County on the 24th of November 2019 where about 20 youths suspected to be members of an outlawed 86 Battalion criminal group attacked members of the public resulting in multiple injuries.

Our security sources indicate that the said machete-wielding gang attacked ten individuals in Kisauni and Nyali constituencies. This prompted immediate police action leading to the arrest of 11 suspects at a hideout in Mwandoni.



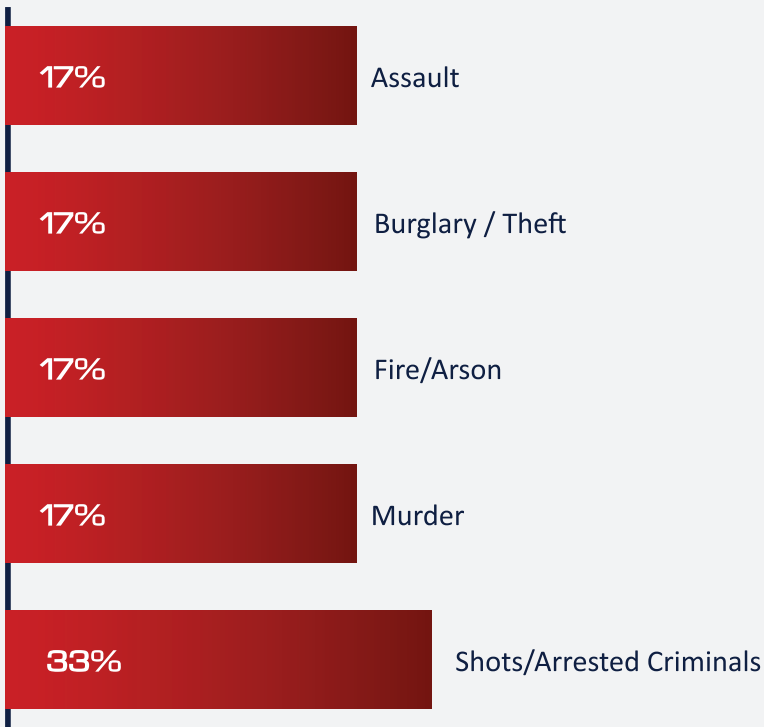
HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The notable incidents recorded in Nairobi included the following:

- A woman was on Tuesday arrested outside Nairobi's City Hall for allegedly duping innocent youth over Ksh. 110,000 with promises of job offers.
- A police officer was on Saturday gunned down alongside other armed thugs at the Mwatate-Ukwala road junction after members of the public raised an alarm about an ongoing robbery in the area.
- A fire on Saturday broke out at a residential premises in Laini Saba near Kwa Kaloki in Kibera, Nairobi.
- A motorist was on Sunday caught on camera assaulting a female security guard at Komarock Phase 5A, Nairobi
- A 25-year-old man was on Sunday arrested for allegedly killing a 33-year-old woman at Silanga area in Kibera.
- Two Toyota Voxy vehicles were on Monday morning stolen from Phenom Estate in Lang'ata.

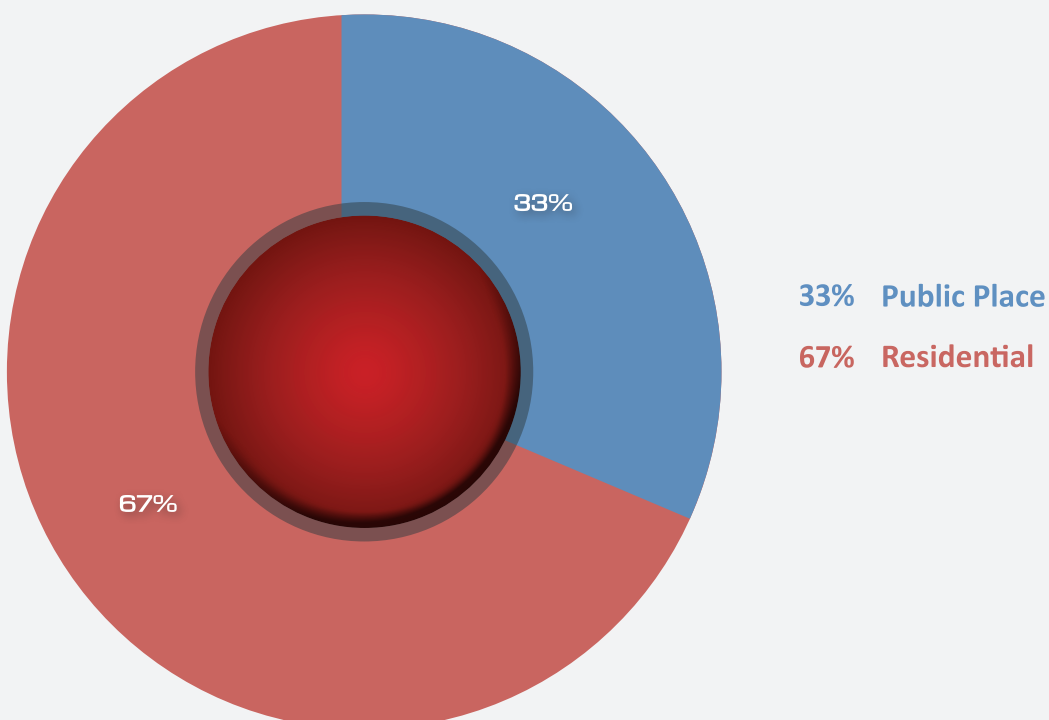

The police crackdown on stolen vehicles saw the arrest of eight suspect of car theft syndicate in Nairobi

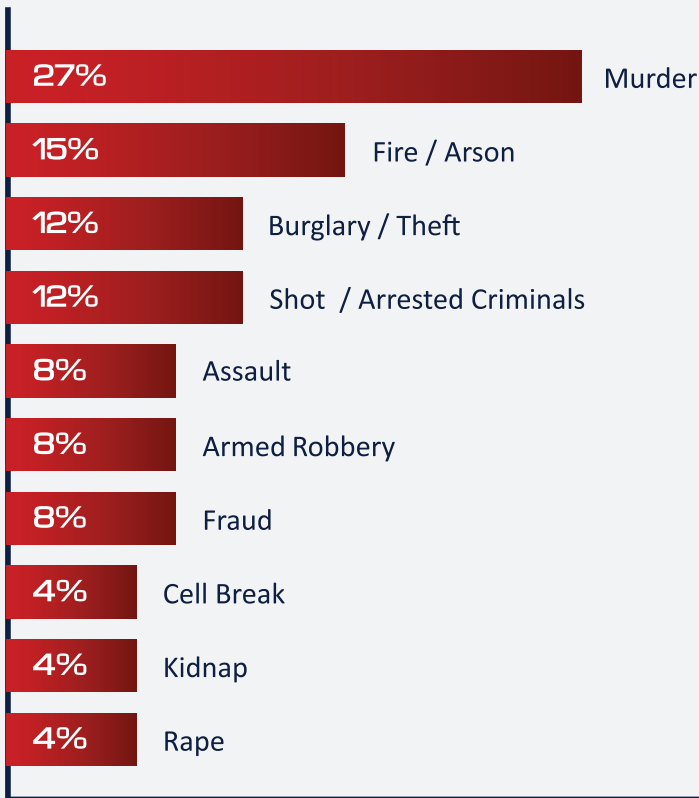
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



Increased security awareness resulted in a decrease of reported incidents against scenes of occurrence as per the above chart

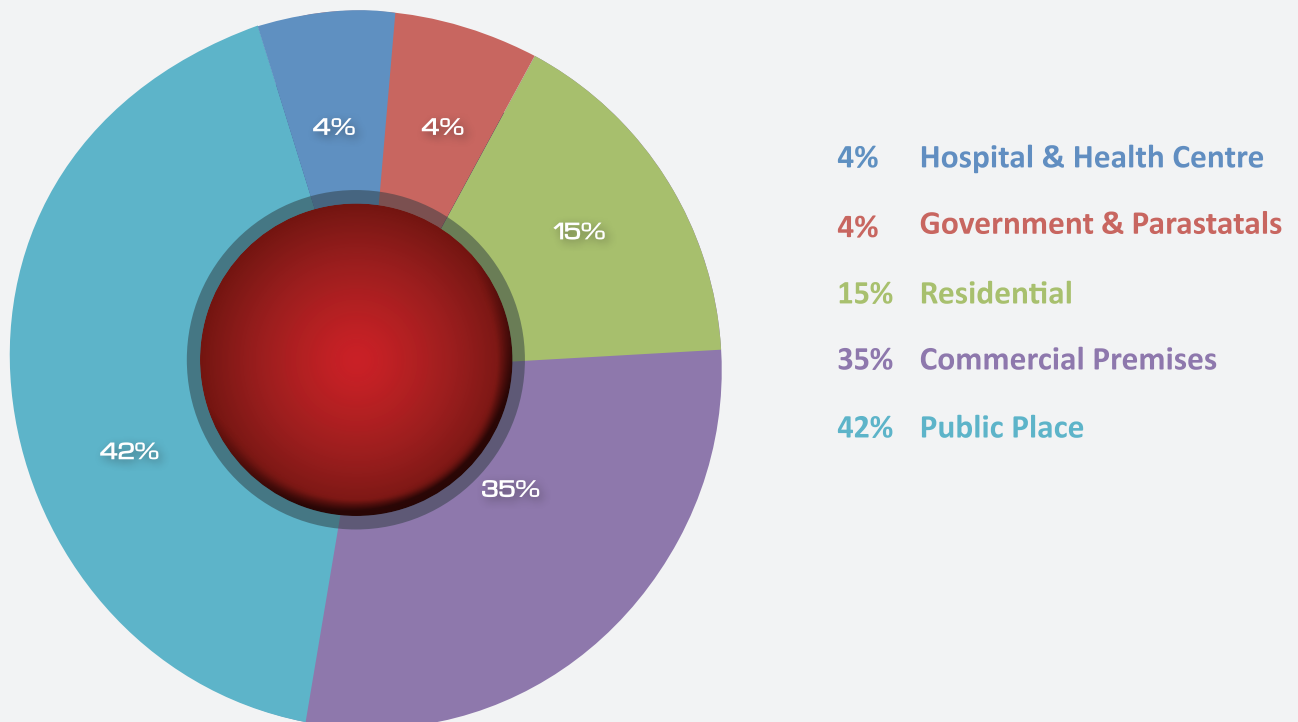

A total of 26 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country

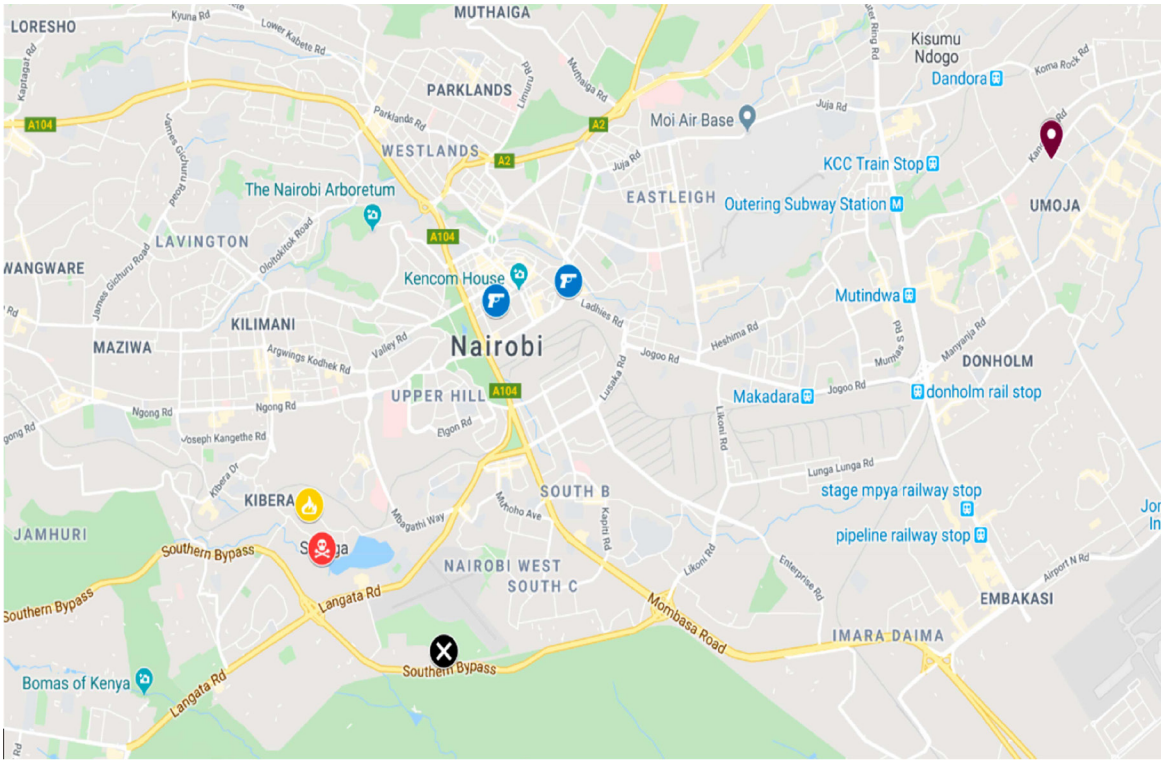
SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS








Similar to Nairobi, the Rest of the Country also witnessed a drop in the number of reported incidents against scenes of occurrence

BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- A gang of thieves on Tuesday night broke into an Airtel shop in Kisumu County and stole laptops, phones and cash all estimated at Ksh. 500,000.
- A supervisor was on Tuesday caught on camera assaulting a cashier at EastMatt Supermarket in Kajiado County.
- Police are searching for two suspects who on Wednesday morning robbed an M-Pesa agent at gunpoint in Mlolongo, Machakos County.
- Two robbery suspects on Wednesday escaped from the police cells at Ruiru Police Station in Kiambu County after they strangled the police officer who was on duty.
- A Siaya-based journalist was on Thursday morning found dead in the house of a female police officer in Ugunja, Siaya County.
- A female University student was on Friday night raped and her arm cut off by three men while on her way home in Kibabii, Bungoma County.
- A police officer was among two suspected armed robbers who were on Friday evening gunned down in Ruaka, Kiambu County.
- Police in Uriri sub-county, Migori County, are hunting for a man who on Saturday allegedly stabbed a 17-year-old pupil to death at Rapogi centre.
- Property worth over Ksh. 4.5 million was on Saturday morning reduced to ashes over suspected business rivalry at Ndhiwa market, Homa Bay County.
- 10 people were on Sunday injured and robbed after they were attacked by a machete wielding gang in Kisauni and Nyali in Mombasa County.
- A woman, her daughter and two grandchildren were on Sunday burned to death after suspected arsonists set their house on fire in Nyunzu market, Makueni County.
- A 45-year-old man was on Monday shot dead by suspected assailants at his farm in Balambala, Garissa County.
- A 43-year-old woman was on Monday night arrested for allegedly stealing a 4-days old infant from the Thika Level Five Hospital in Kiambu County.
