OVERVIEW

The first week of November saw a notable reduction in the number of crime incidents reported across the Country. Our security sources attributed the said reduction to increased patrols and raids by the different security agencies resulting in numerous arrests made in connection to robberies, murders and fraud.

Other than the above, the police service has issued a red alert on the risks of teenagers and youths getting involved in criminal activities while on long holidays. Parents and guardians are advised to ensure that their children are always in a secure environment at any given time following the closure of a majority of schools for the December holidays.




HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI


The notable incidents recorded in Nairobi included the following:

- University of Nairobi students on Tuesday disrupted traffic as they
 protested the death of their colleague who was hit by an
 ambulance at the gate of the institution along University Way.
- Passengers on Friday night lost their belonging after suspected armed robbers hijacked a bus heading to Donholm and diverted it to Koma Rock road.
- A suspected thug was on Saturday night shot dead in a botched robbery at a building in Matopeni area, Kayole.
- A motor vehicle was on Sunday reported stolen from Parklands in Nairobi.
- A man impersonating the Nairobi County Governor was on Monday arrested at a city hotel where he had gone to allegedly collect Ksh. 80,000 from one of his victim.
- An Administration police officer and an employee of a private security firm were on Monday arrested after they attempted to steal from a bar operator in Obama Estate.

There was a notable reduction of robbery related incidents following increased police night patrols.




The incidents reported in the corresponding scenes of incidents were at their lowest number in comparison to a similar period last year

ANALYSIS OF CRIME INCIDENTS IN KENYA






A total of 15 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country



There was a significant number of incidents reported in Government and Parastatals on the first week of November.


AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA


BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS



- A 21-year-old man is accused to have on Tuesday night raped an elderly woman at Mulot area in Bomet County.
- Suspected militants on Tuesday night raided Dadajabula police station in Wajir County and killed two of their detained accomplices.
- Police on Wednesday arrested two suspects and impounded a lorry ferrying 390 cartons of contraband cigarettes worth Ksh. 27 million in Eldoret, Uasin Gishu County.
- One robbery with violence suspect was on Wednesday gunned down and two AK rifles with 18 live rounds of ammunition recovered by the Special Crime Police Unit at Katani area in Mlolongo, Machakos County.
- Property worth more than Ksh.
 30 million was on Thursday destroyed after a fire broke out at Galole CDF offices in Hola, Tana River County.
- A clinical officer is accused to have on Thursday stolen drugs

- and hospital equipment worth Ksh.200,000 from Mivukoni Health Centre in Kyuso, Kitui County.
- A police constable was on Saturday gunned down by his colleagues after he became violent shortly after killing his father at Chepkono area of West Pokot County.
- A gang of three men is accused to have on Saturday raped an elderly woman in a village in Lower Yatta Sub-County, Kitui County.
- Suspected goons on Sunday interrupted a church service and destroyed property after they attacked faithful at the Holy Trinity Church of Africa in Migori County.
- A 25-year-old man was on Monday beaten to death after he failed to pay a Ksh.100 debt at an illicit liquor den in Kajoro village, Busia County.
- A young woman was on Monday found murdered at Noonkopir area of Kitengela, Kajiado County.
