

# WEEKLY CRIME REPORT

26th November - 2nd December '19

## **OVERVIEW**

Of particular concern in the week under reference is the plan by the Government to intensify safety and security measures over the next two months in the lead up to the festive season.

While our previous crime report issue reported of a resurgence of criminal gangs in the Coastal region, our security sources indicate that police officers over the weekend ambushed and arrested at least nine suspects of two outlawed machetewielding groups in Kisauni, Mombasa County.




## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI


The notable incidents recorded in Nairobi included the following:

- Two young men were on Tuesday night cornered by residents of Nairobi's Makongeni area as they attempted to snatch a handbag while on a motorbike.
- An assortment of gas cylinders believed to have been set for refilling with counterfeit gas were on Friday confiscated at gas refilling plant in Syokimau area along Mombasa Road in Nairobi County.
- Administration Police officers on Friday subdued suspected armed robbers near the Powerstar Supermarket in Kasarani, Nairobi County.
- Two men alleged to be police constables were on Saturday arrested after they attempted to carjack an Uber driver in Eastleigh estate, Nairobi.
- An armed robber was on Saturday gunned down following a shootout with DCI detectives along the Southern Bypass, Nairobi.
   The man in his twenties was ambushed by detectives who had received an intelligence of a planned robbery on the busy road.
- Three gunmen on Monday night shot and injured two people following a robbery incident at a shop in Nairobi's Fedha Estate.

Unlike the norm, there were no serious crime-related activities reported in residential areas


## ANALYSIS OF CRIME INCIDENTS IN KENYA





A total of 23 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country


## SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



There was slight increase in the number of incidents reported in Public Places as compared to the previous week


## AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI & KENYA

## BELOW ARE SOME OF THE KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS




- Three robbery with violence suspects were on Tuesday arrested and an AK47 rifle which was robbed from a police constable was recovered at a residential house in Mauko area, Busia County.
- A 32-year-old boda boda rider was on Tuesday beaten to death after a fracas erupted between two rival groups of boda boda riders in Kitale town, Trans Nzoia County.
- Seven wanted criminals believed to have been involved in various criminal activities in Kisauni, Mombasa County were on the night of Wednesday arrested from their hideout by DCI detectives.
- One person on Wednesday died and property worth millions of shillings destroyed after a fire broke out at Kapkugerwet trading centre in Kericho County.
- A man was on Thursday shot dead after he snatched a gun from a police officer manning a local bank in Bondeni area, Mombasa County.

- A 17-year-old boy is reported to have on Thursday stabbed a 16-year-old girl to death for allegedly rejecting his sexual advances at Mirera estate in Nakuru County.
- Police in Mwingi, Kitui County on Friday rescued 10 teenage girls from rental houses where they had allegedly been defiled by a local pastor.
- A family is demanding justice after their kin was on Friday allegedly murdered in a lodging facility in Athi River, Machakos County.
- A man is accused to have on Saturday abducted a police officer in Kisumu town, Kisumu County.
- Three men suspected to be members of outlawed militant group were on Saturday arrested inside a bus headed to Nairobi in Thika, Kiambu County.
- A 28-year-old woman was on Sunday found murdered at a guest house within Wote town, Makueni County.

- Two police officers on patrol in Mararani area of Lamu County were on Sunday beaten and tied up by residents who accused them of harassment.
- Three people were on Monday killed and one injured after suspected armed bandits attacked Kapau area of Tiaty sub-county, Baringo County.
- A woman was on Monday shot and injured following an armed robbery attack at her store in Soko Mjinga, Isiolo County.
