


AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN KENYA

Increased security awareness from the police and public noted a significant decrease in the number of reported crimes and averted occurrences of heinous attack in the Country. Noted in our security sources are the arrest of five suspicious persons conducting surveillance at Whiskey River Lounge in Nairobi and the crackdown of immigrants across the country with no valid identification documents.

OVERVIEW

Other than the above, cases of fire were of great concern with particular focus being on schools fires reported at Bahati Girls School, Riabai High School, and Awasi Boys High School. Police have launched investigations into these fires since some of the school administrators suspected foul play.






HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The notable incidents recorded in Nairobi included the following:

- Five car engines and other motor vehicle accessories were on Tuesday reported stolen from a garage in Kayole, Nairobi.
- Seven suspects of armed robbery were on Tuesday arrested by detectives in Kilimani area of Nairobi.
- A 24-year-old man was on Thursday allegedly shot dead by a police officer following a raid within Mashimoni area in Pumwani, Nairobi.
- A legislator was on Friday arrested by detectives following a shooting incident at B Club located along Galana Road within Kilimani, Nairobi.
- More than 1200 gambling machines were on Friday seized by detectives at a private residence in Nairobi's Runda Estate.
- A police officer is nursing head injuries after he was on Monday morning attacked and robbed of his gun by a gang of thugs in Dandora area, Nairobi.




ANALYSIS OF CRIME INCIDENTS

KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS FROM AROUND KENYA

- The body of a 30-year-old man that had physical injuries on the head and hands was on Tuesday found dumped at Kirengero trading centre in Subukia, Nakuru County.
- A 27-year-old Imam was on Wednesday night allegedly abducted while on his way home from night prayers in Kombani, Kwale County.
- Thieves on Wednesday night broke into the Anglican Church of Kenya at Passenga Township in Nyandarua County and made away with electronic equipment among other valuables.
- Police are on the hunt for a gang that shot and injured three people during a Thursday night raid at Githagara in Kahuro, Murang'a County.
- A traffic police officer is fighting for his life after he was on Thursday injured by thieves who robbed him of his firearm along the Murang'a – Sagana Road in Murang'a County.
- Police in Kiambu County are investigating the cause of a fire that on Friday consumed a dormitory at Riabai High School.
- Heavily armed cattle rustlers on Friday staged a raid at Natur village in Baringo County and stole more than 40 heads of cattle belonging to a local primary school head teacher.
- A student on Saturday died and five others were admitted at the hospital


after a fire burnt down a dormitory at Bahati PCEA Girls Secondary School in Nakuru County.

- A 25-year-old man is alleged to have on Saturday killed his wife at Wagogo village in Homa Bay County over domestic wrangles.
- Police who had received an alert on Sunday shot dead two men and found a homemade pistol at Kahawa Wendani, Kiambu County.
- A family from Gathara village in Kinangop, Nyandarua County spent Sunday night in the cold after their house was razed by a mysterious fire.
- The body of a young woman was on Monday found stashed in a sack by the roadside at Kaaga village, Meru County.
- More than 400 tonnes of processed sisal were on Monday destroyed after a fire broke out at Lomolo Sisal Factory in Makongeni, Rongao in Nakuru County.




