


OVERVIEW

AN AFRIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN KENYA

The incidents of mysterious murders and thefts reported in Nairobi and the Rest of the Country have raised concerns among members of the public. In this week under reference, our security sources, for instance, report on the killing of a city tycoon in Westlands and the brutal murder of a couple at Itenji village in Vihiga County. Also captured are the increased cases of thefts reported in educational institutions with a particular focus on primary schools where burglars target computer tablets and electronics.

In regards to the above, the security agencies have assured the public of their safety and called for any reliable information that will lead to the arrest of culprits behind these heinous acts.






HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WEEK NAIROBI

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- A 20-year-old tenant was on Tuesday allegedly killed by his landlord following a row in rent payments at Kawangware 56 area of Nairobi County.
- Suspected assailants on Friday night killed a tycoon at his house located along Donyo Sabuk Lane in Westlands, Nairobi County
- A motorist was on Friday allegedly robbed across Villa Rosa Kempinski in Nairobi by thugs armed with machetes and other crude weapons.
- A fire on Saturday evening broke out at a workshop and spread to a study block at Starehe Boys Centre in Nairobi County.
- Property of unknown value was on Saturday destroyed after a fire erupted at a hardware shop on the Sheikh Karume Road in Nairobi.
- A murder suspect was on Monday night arrested at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport as he boarded a plane to the United State of America.

AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI







In this reporting week, Residential Areas recorded slightly increase cases of foul murders




KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS FROM AROUND KENYA

- Suspected militants on Tuesday night shot dead a National Police Reservist at Bula Golol area in Hulugho Sub-County, Garissa County.
- Tension remained high at Maron area of Elgeyo Marakwet County after 50 houses were on Tuesday torched in suspected ethnic clashes following a land dispute.
- Police on Wednesday arrested a man in connection with the murder of two boys whose mutilated bodies were retrieved from a sewer at Gikumari area in Kiambu County.
- Al Shabaab militants on Wednesday night raided Gedilun village in Garissa County and burnt down houses belonging to National Police Reservists .
- A middle-aged man was on Thursday arrested after he was caught on CCTV cameras stealing from the church coffers in Murang'a County.
- A policeman was arrested after he on Friday aided four robbery with violence suspects to escape from Sagana Police Station in Kirinyaga County.
- Police in Mombasa County are holding a constable attached to Railways Police Station, who they suspect to be among thugs who steal from the public. The Friday arrest comes after a woman was robbed of Ksh. 550,000.00 while coming from the bank.


- A seven-year girl is recovering in a Kisumu Hospital after she was on Saturday allegedly defiled by her two cousins at their home in Luanda, Vihiga County.
- Three suspects were on Saturday arrested and counterfeit gas cylinders confiscated after police raided a gas filling plant at Muthatari in Embu County.
- Police in Keringet in Kuresoi South, Nakuru County are holding a 19-yearold student who is suspected to have on Sunday killed his colleague over Ksh. 50.
- A woman and her 11-month-old baby were on Sunday night shot and injured by armed robbers who robbed them of undisclosed amount of money at Hongera area near Soko Mjinga in Mombasa County.
- Thieves on Monday broke into two schools in Machakos County and stole tablets and other electronics.
- A man and his wife were on Monday brutally murdered by unknown assailants at their house in Itenji village, Vihiga County.






Residential Areas in Rest of the Country recorded an increased number of incidents with a particular focus on foul murder cases
