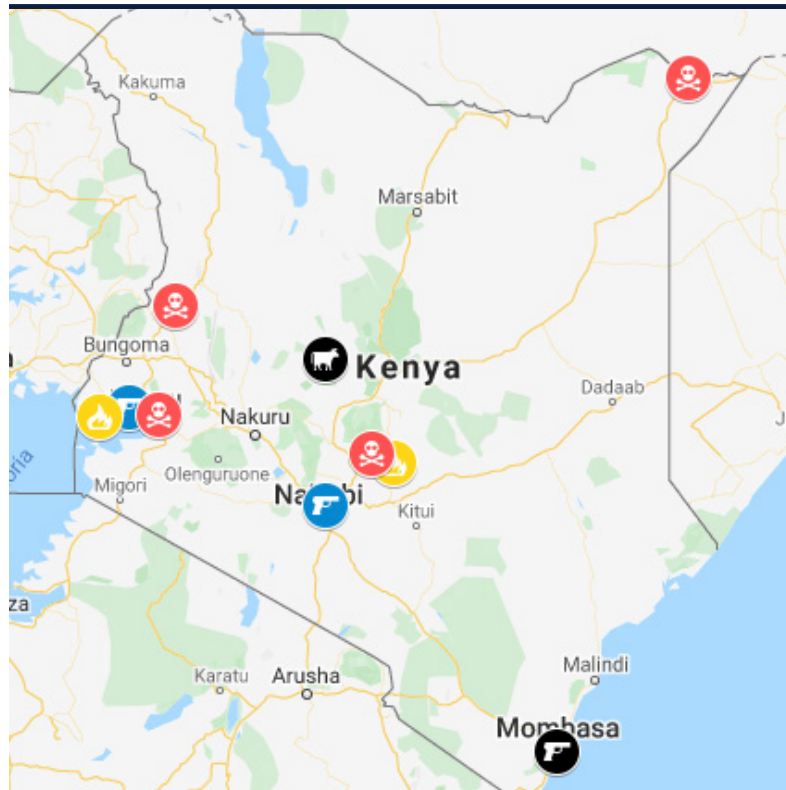

OVERVIEW

AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN KENYA

Panic ensued following the announcement by The Ministry of Health on 12th March reporting the first case of COVID-19 breakout in Kenya. As of 18th March, the number had risen to 7 with more suspected cases being reported in the country. The government through the ministry of health has continued to advice members of the public to be extra vigilant when visiting public places like restaurants and malls. In light of this, a 23-year-old man was apprehended and charged by the DCI for publishing misleading information about the spread of corona virus in Kenya on social media platforms. In addition to that, two suspects were on Tuesday arrested at Avane Cosmetic Dermatology Clinic & Medical Spa, Yaya centre for distributing fake testing kits for Corona Virus. The government has reassured the public that they are taking key necessary precautions towards combating and preventing the spread of the virus. As a result, Kenyans are advised to exercise caution by maintaining high standards of hygiene and avoiding crowded places to help prevent the further spread of the virus.

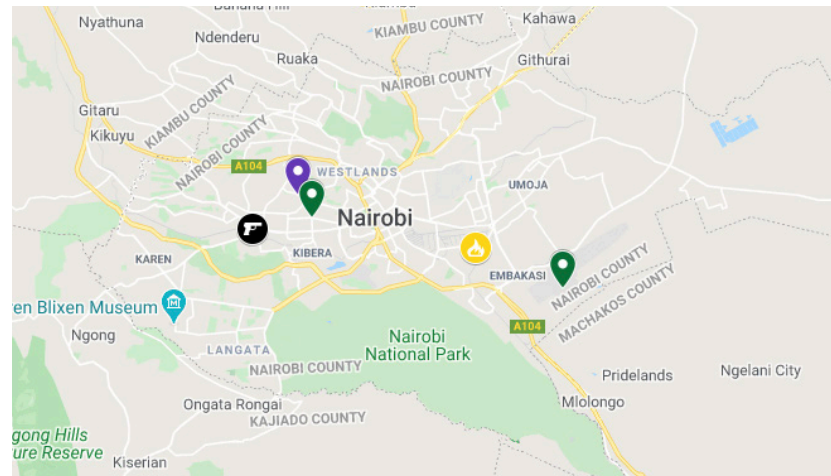

The key crime-related incidents reported in Nairobi included:

- Suspected thugs on Tuesday night raided an M-Pesa outlet at Nairobi's Dagoretti Corner along Wanyee road and stole unknown amount of money.
- Special services unit detectives from the DCI on Thursday night arrested a boda boda operator accused of raping his client of a foreign nationality, while en-route to Kileleshwa, Nairobi County.
- Property of unknown value was on Saturday destroyed after a fire broke out at Metro Plastics Kenya Ltd in Nairobi's Industrial Area.
- DCI Detectives based at JKIA in Nairobi County on Sunday arrested a Kenyan pilot working with a local aviation company in connection with investigations into the 39 Billion fake arms deal.
- Two suspects of Avane Cosmetic Dermatology Clinic & Medical Spa were on Monday arrested by the DCI at Yaya Centre in Nbi county for selling fake Corona virus testing kits.

AN AERIAL VIEW OF SECURITY INCIDENTS IN NAIROBI



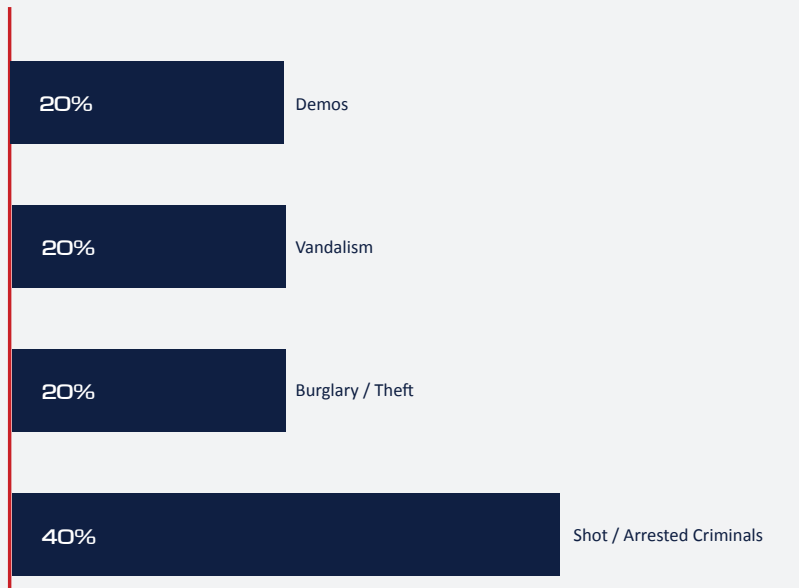

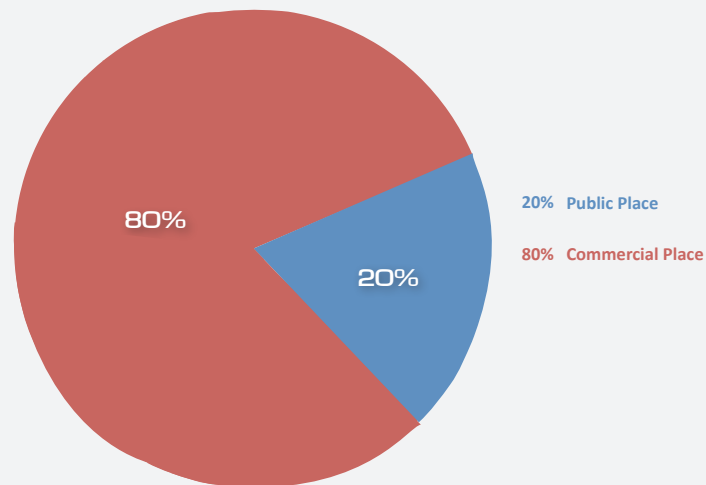

SCENE OF INCIDENTS ANALYSIS IN RELATION TO INCIDENTS



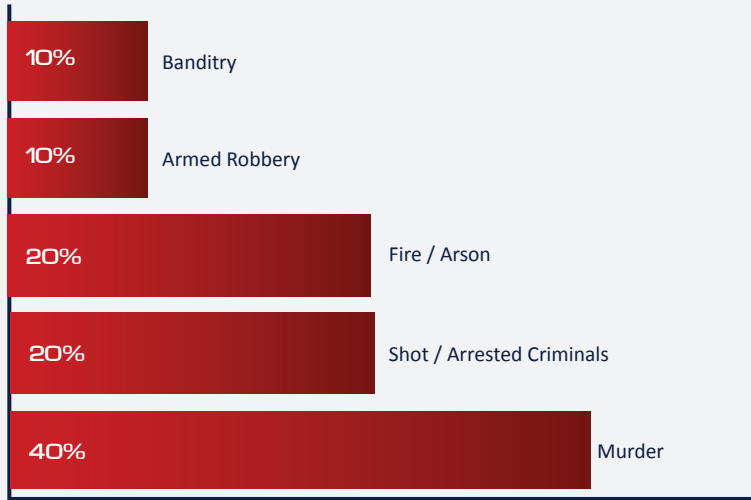
There was a general reduction of incidents as per the above chart on scene of incidents

KEY SECURITY INCIDENTS FROM AROUND KENYA

- A man was on Tuesday attacked by goons in Mombasa while going about his business and stripped of his valuables.
- Two people were on Wednesday killed by suspected Al Shabaab gunmen in Rhamu, Mandera County.
- Police in Kapenguria are looking for a 46 year old man who reportedly beat his wife to death on Wednesday after he found her with another man at their home in Koropwon village, West Pokot County.
- A night guard manning Marikiti market in Embu County was on Thursday allegedly killed by unknown people while on duty.
- Goods worth thousands of shillings was on Thursday destroyed after a fire broke out within market stalls in Embu town, Embu County.
- Police have launched an investigation into a fire incident that broke out on Friday at Maranda High School in Siaya County following students protests over bad food.
- A 55 year old man was arrested on Friday by police officers after he hacked his 63 year old brother to death in a suspected love triangle incident at Achuodho village in Kisumu County.
- Police officers working in conjunction with villagers at Naperere area in Laikipia North recovered 38 stolen cows following a Saturday ambush by bandits from Samburu County.
- A man linked to the gang rape of a census enumerator in Maseno was arrested on Friday in Luanda town, Vihiga County.
- Two suspects of robbery with violence were on Sunday arrested by Police officers on patrol along the Northern bypass in Ruiru town, Kiambu County.

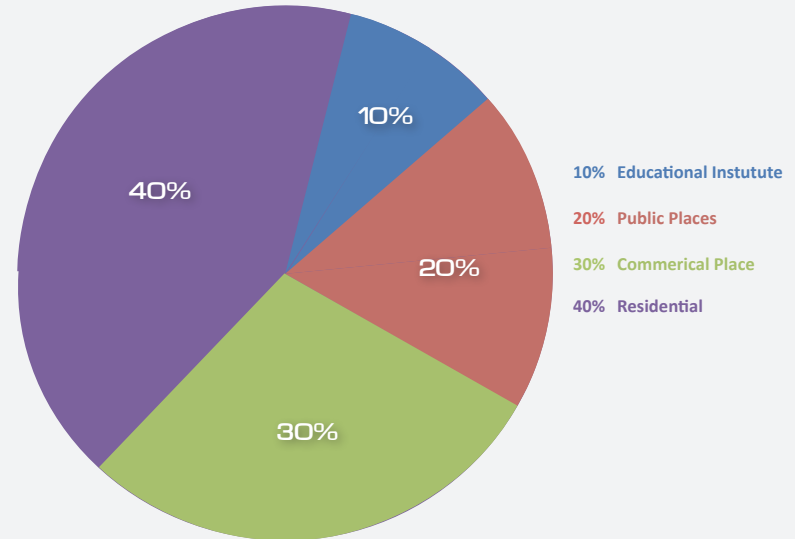

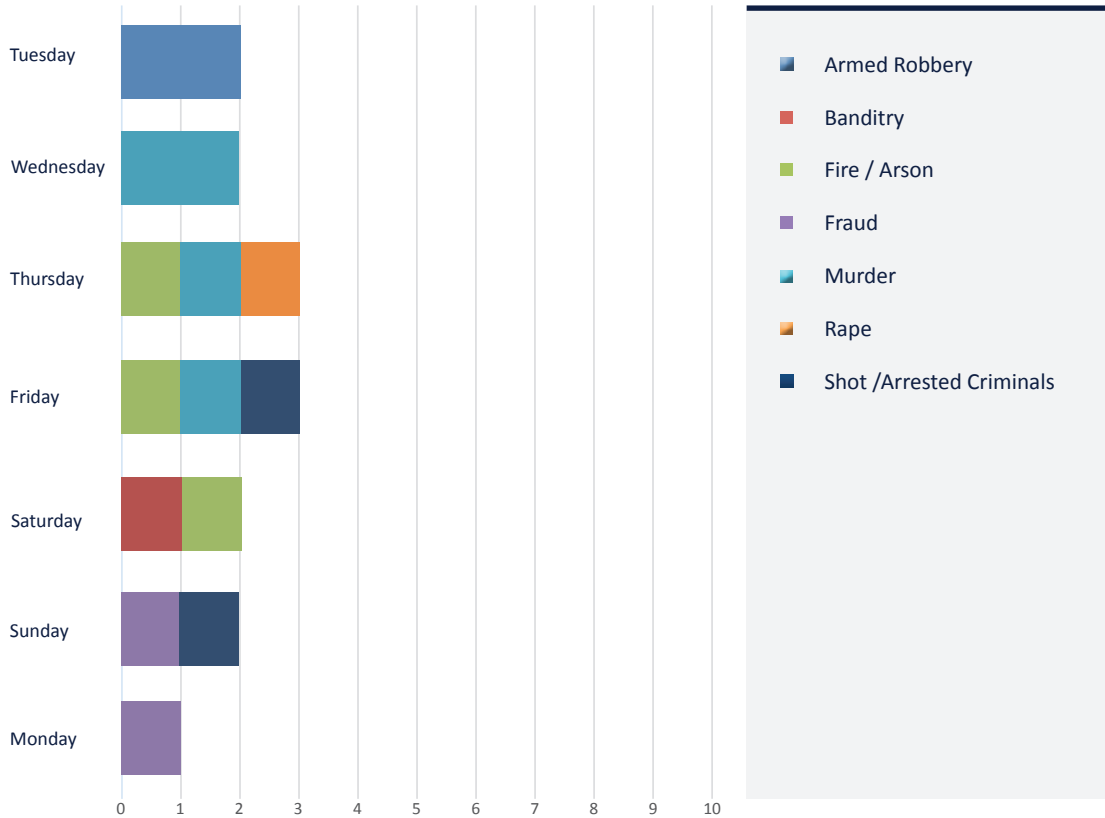
A total of 10 incidents were recorded in the Rest of the Country
